On 1/20/13, a fight broke out in the Celebrity Bar and Grill between patrons at the conclusion of the Ravens/Patriots football game. PPD and MDTA police responded and helped security break up the fight. No charges were brought against any participants. One security guard was struck in the face while interceding and received a minor injury.

On 1/21/13, a fight broke out between two (2) female patrons in a dispute over a VLT. PPD officers responded and the female who first struck the other female was arrested for assault.

Theft/Robbery: 0

Employee Theft: 1

On 1/9/13, security began an investigation into an employee theft of a voucher valued at \$60.76. The investigation revealed that on this date, a female slot attendant noticed a voucher that had been left on top of VLT I1204 by a slot technician. The technicians are not allowed to handle cash or vouchers, so he notified the slots attendant that it had to be taken to the cage, as per policy. Instead of taking the voucher to the cage, the attendant went to a patron and had the patron remove the voucher and cash it out at the redemption machine.
