#### STATE-FUNDED PROGRAMS

In Fiscal Year 2010, \$510.6 million was contributed to the State of Maryland. This revenue helps support state-funded services and programs such as education, public health, public safety, human resources, and the environment.

Commissions and fees are paid to all licensed ticket retailers for selling and cashing tickets.

#### OPERATIONAL EXPENSES
