- 1) ITLM Update As of 6/12/19, 363 ITLMs in 86 unique Veterans' Posts are currently operational. The ITLM Program as a whole has contributed over \$18.6 million in profits to the participating Posts since September 2014.
- 2) The number of posts adding ITLM Phase II (Prizes over \$600) machines continues to increase. There are now 41 posts participating.
- 3) ITLM sales in May 2019 (\$896,997) increased by 13% compared to May 2018 (\$793,937).

### D Responsible Gambling

- 1) Voluntary Exclusion Program
  - a) 42 new participants joined the casino VEP program in May; the current number of active participants is 2,166.
  - b) There were 4 removals from the VEP in May and 318 in total.
  - c) To date, 822 violations have occurred since the casino VEP began. All violators are cited for criminal trespass.
  - d) There were 7 additional enrollments on the lottery VEP list and 1 removal; the total number of participants is 357.
  - e) There are currently 16 participants in the bingo hall VEP program.
- 2) The launch of the new electronic VEP notification process is currently in progress.
