- 1) ITLM Update - As of 12/4/19, 377 ITLMs in 89 unique Veterans' Posts are currently operational. The ITLM Program as a whole has contributed over \$21.1 million in profits to the participating Posts since September 2014.
- 2) ITLM sales in November 2019 (\$917,006) increased by 19.6% compared to November 2018 (\$766,736).
- 3) Phase II machines (prizes over \$600) are now offered in 51 posts.
- 4) Diamond Games has begun deployment of their print-on-the-fly hardware at Instant Bingo Halls in AA County.
- 5) Chesapeake Beach Resort remodel/expansion project is underway.
- 6) Newly licensed Instant Bingo manufacturer Bluberi has installed machines (first in the jurisdiction) at Chesapeake Beach Resort.

D Responsible Gambling

- 1) Voluntary Exclusion Program
 - a) 30 new participants joined the casino VEP in November; the current number of active participants is 2,331.
 - b) There were 12 removals from the VEP in November and 377 in total.
 - c) To date, 941 violations have occurred since the casino VEP began. All violators are cited for criminal trespass.
 - d) There were 4 additional enrollments in the lottery VEP and 1 removal; the total number of participants is 395.
 - e) There are currently 23 participants in the bingo hall VEP.
- 2) The launch of the new electronic VEP notification process is currently in progress.
