11 **B.** Instant tickets that a retailer activates before a ticket’s announced end of game may be sold
12 by the retailer after the ticket’s announced end of game and until the last date to claim a
13 prize for that game.

21 A. A holder of a winning ticket may claim a prize for a winning ticket:

5 **.05 Documents Required for Prize Payment.**

6 A. To perfect a claim and receive payment of an Agency prize, a winner shall meet all
7 requirements in this subtitle for claiming.

8 B. To claim a prize, a winner shall submit:

9 (1) For other than subscription winners, the actual original ticket, which shall:

10 (a) Meet the validation requirements of this subtitle; and

11 (b) Be signed by all winners **if requested**; and

12 (2) If requested, photo identification proof that the winner is at least 18 years old.

13 C. For a prize claimed at an Agency claim center and for any prize over \$600 claimed at a
14 retailer, in addition to the documents required under §B of this regulation a winner shall:

15 **(1) Sign the original ticket;**

16 **(2) Provide necessary information to the retailer to produce a terminal-generated claim**
17 **form;**

18 **(3) Submit** ~~submit~~ a fully completed **and signed** claim form; **and**

19 **(4) Provide** ~~and~~ sufficient information to identify the claimant, such as:

20 ~~(4)~~ **(a)** The winner's Social Security number;
