7 **.30 Progressive Proposal.**

8 (A. – C. text unchanged)

9 D. A transfer of an available progressive jackpot amount under §C(2) of this regulation shall
10 involve:

11 (1) The entire amount;

12 (2) Transfer to the:

13 (a) Progressive meter of a video lottery terminal with the same:

14 (i) Or greater probability of winning the progressive jackpot;

15 (ii) Or lower wager requirement to be eligible to win the progressive jackpot; and

16 (iii) Type of progressive jackpot award; or

17 (b) Progressive meters of two separate video lottery terminals provided each terminal to
18 which a jackpot amount is transferred individually satisfies the requirements of §D(2)(a) of this
19 regulation; and

20 (3) Disclosure of the intent to transfer an available progressive jackpot amount on the front
21 of a video lottery terminal in a manner specified by the Commission for at least ~~10~~ **14** days prior
22 to the intended date of transfer.

The proposed amendment would require a facility to disclose the transfer of a progressive jackpot on the front of a video lottery terminal 14 days prior to the intended date of transfer. This change makes the disclosure requirement consistent throughout the chapter.

23 E. Removal from the gaming floor of a video lottery terminal offering a progressive jackpot
24 under §C(3) of this regulation shall require:

25 (1) If the removal involves one or more linked video lottery terminals offered in:

26 (a) A single facility, that at least two linked video lottery terminals offering the same
27 progressive jackpot remain on the gaming floor; and

28 (b) More than one facility, that the facility operator retain at least one linked video lottery
29 terminal offering the same progressive jackpot on its gaming floor; and

30 (2) In every case, disclosure of the intent to transfer an available progressive jackpot on the
31 front of a video lottery terminal in a manner specified by the Commission for at least 14 days
32 prior to the intended date of transfer.

33 F. Nothing in this regulation shall preclude the Commission from imposing additional terms
34 and conditions on a modification of a progressive proposal.
