This is a status update of ongoing and special projects in Finance.

I. <u>BUDGET</u>

• FISCAL YEAR 2020 Final Expenditures

Lottery: \$77,743,420
VLT Special Fund: \$10,842,801
VLT General Fund: \$6,461,424
COVID 19 – Fund 9: \$95,651

• FISCAL YEAR 2021 (was reduced by \$119,756, see approved budget amounts below). DBM provided MLGCA with an additional \$2,734,554 budget appropriation. This budget increase was primarily for the SGI contract and was because of the increased sales in this fiscal year. UPDATE: An additional budget request of \$4,250,000 has been requested and is also for the SGI contract and the increased sales.

• FISCAL YEAR 2022

The Fiscal Year 2022 budget has been finalized by the legislature. Our advertising budget was reduced by \$2 million.
