NOTICE

Maryland's Sports Wagering Law is long and complex. It is located in State Government Article, Title 9, Subtitle 1E, Annotated Code of Maryland ("SG"). The regulations promulgated by the Maryland Lottery and Gaming Control Commission ("Commission") are found in Code of Maryland Regulations ("COMAR") 36.10. Collectively, SG § 9-1E *et seq.* and COMAR 36.10 are referred herein as the "Sports Wagering Law". In addition to the Sports Wagering Law, other relevant authority for the Sports Wagering Law is found in SG § 9-1A *et seq.* and COMAR 36.03, collectively referred to as the "Gaming Law".

The cites referenced within this disclosure form are for explanatory purposes, are subject to change, may be different from what is provided, and should not be relied upon. You are expected to be familiar with the current Sports Wagering Law and Gaming Law; updates and information may be found at https://www.mdgaming.com/.

Failure or refusal to adhere to Sports Wagering Law may result in the Commission imposing sanctions and/or penalties, to include, but not limited to, the placing of conditions on a sports wagering license; suspension or revocation of a sports wagering license; reprimand of a licensee; and/or fines, and may result in criminal and/or civil charges being filed against the licensee.

APPLICABILITY

The Commission is required to investigate an Applicant for a sports wagering license pursuant to the Sports Wagering Law. An Applicant for a sports wagering license must establish by clear and convincing evidence that the Applicant is qualified for licensure, and must not be subject to any grounds for mandatory disqualification from license eligibility. SG § 9-1E-07(e)(1); COMAR 36.10.03.

As part of the investigation to determine whether an Applicant meets all legal requirements and qualifications for licensure, the Applicant must disclose to the Commission all principal employees, as defined in COMAR 36.10.01, and principal entities. COMAR 36.10.02. A principal entity means a person, other than an individual, that is a principal. COMAR 36.03.01.02. The background investigation of the principal entity shall be conducted as part of the background investigation into an applicant for one of the following: Sports Wagering Facility License; Sports Wagering Facility Operator License; Mobile Sports Wagering License; Online Sports Wagering Operator License; or a Sports Wagering Contractor License (referred herein singularly as "Applicant")

A principal entity may request the Commission waive the requirement of conducting a full background investigation if it meets the definition of an institutional investor. COMAR 36.10.02. An institutional investor for purposes of the Sports Wagering Law is defined in COMAR 36.10.01. An institutional investor must complete a Sports Wagering Institutional Waiver Application in order for the Commission to assess whether to waive the requirement of conducting a full background investigation of the principal entity. COMAR 36.10.02.

WAIVER SUBMISSION

WAIVER ELIGIBILITY

The Commission may approve a principal entity's request for a waiver if it meets one of the definitions of institutional investor as defined in COMAR 36.10.01; and satisfactorily completes and submits this Sports Wagering Institutional Investor Application Form #4007. COMAR 36.10.02.

The Commission's decision whether to approve a waiver is discretionary, and may be based on facts including: the institutional investor's securities; whether the institutional investor is substantially involved in the Applicant's sports wagering operations; whether the institutional investor is substantially involved in the Applicant's gaming operations; the institutional investor's sports wagering licensure history; or the institutional investor's gaming licensure history in Maryland or any other jurisdiction.

An institutional investor may submit this Sports Wagering Institutional Investor Waiver Application (Form #4007) instead of a Sports Wagering Principal Entity Disclosure Form (Form #4006). If the Commission approves the institutional investor's waiver request, the institutional investor is not required to file the Principal Entity Disclosure (Form #4006).

If the Commission denies the institutional investor's waiver request, the institutional investor must promptly complete and submit a Sports Wagering Principal Entity Disclosure Form (Form #4006).

SUBMISSION OF WAIVER APPLICATION

The Sports Wagering Institutional Investor Waiver Application Form 4007 is submitted to the Commission **electronically** via the Maryland Lottery and Gaming Control Agency's 'eLicensing' system. Paper applications for a Sports Wagering Institutional Investor Waiver <u>will not</u> be accepted by the Commission.

Note: The Applicant is required to designate an individual to administer the submission of the Sports Wagering Institutional Waiver Applications for the Applicant. The designated 'eLicensing' Administrator will be required to contact the Licensing Division (<u>gaming.services@maryland.gov</u>) as soon as possible to allow sufficient time for the Licensing Division staff to provide comprehensive instruction prior to the initiation of the process.

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SECTION A - IMPORTANT NOTICES

- A.1 This form is an official document of the Maryland Lottery and Gaming Control Commission ("Commission") and is to be used for informational purposes only. All Sports Wagering Institutional Investor Waiver applicants must use the Maryland Lottery and Gaming Control Agency's online 'eLicensing' system for submittal of applications. Paper Waiver Applications <u>will not</u> be accepted.
- **A.2** All statements <u>must</u> be complete, accurate, truthful and include all material facts. Any misrepresentation, failure to provide any requested information, or failure to meet any other requirement during the application process or throughout the entire term of any license subsequently issued by the Commission, as set forth in the Sports Wagering Law or Gaming Law, may result in the Commission taking action against the Applicant or Licensee, up to and including the denial of the license application; or revocation of any license issued; and may subject the Applicant to the imposition of monetary fines or civil and/or criminal penalties.
- **A.3** The Applicant is responsible for the payment of all application and background investigation fees required under the Sports Wagering Law and Gaming Law and the posting of a bond that may be required by the Commission. The application will not be processed until the fees are submitted. Additionally, the Applicant is ultimately responsible for payment to the Commission of the administrative costs associated with the Institutional Investor's background investigation. Any payment arrangement between the Applicant and the Institutional Investor does not relieve Applicant of the responsibility to pay the fees due to the Commission.
- A.4 The burden of proving qualifications is at all times on the Institutional Investor. The Institutional Investor accepts any and all risk of adverse public notice, embarrassment, criticism, emotional distress or financial loss that may result from any action with respect to this Waiver Application. The Institutional Investor expressly waives any and all claims for damages as result thereof. Information not called for in this Waiver Application or in addition to that which is provided in response to this Waiver Application may be requested. The Institutional Investor shall provide all information, documents, materials and certifications at the Institutional Investor's expense.

- A.5 The Institutional Investor has a continuing obligation to promptly provide written notification to the Commission of any corrections or changes to the Waiver Application once submitted, and to any of the materials submitted in connection with this Waiver Application. The duty to make such additional disclosures or notify the Commission of any change or correction shall continue throughout any period of Applicant's licensure.
- **A.6** All notices regarding the Waiver Application will be sent to the address provided by the Institutional Investor on this Waiver Application. All notices regarding the application will be sent to the address provided by the Applicant on the application. The Institutional Investor or Applicant must immediately notify the Commission of any change of address.
- **A.7** Any attempt by the Institutional Investor to withdraw or retract this Waiver Application may jeopardize the Applicant's application, and the Institutional Investor shall be solely responsible for the consequences of such action.
- **A.8** All submissions with and for this Waiver Application and the Applicant's application become the property of the Commission and <u>will not</u> be returned.
- **A.9** The Maryland Lottery and Gaming Control Agency's Regulatory Licensing and Background Investigations Division is referred to, throughout this application, as the "Licensing Division".

SECTION B - INSTRUCTIONS

- **B.1** This Sports Wagering Institutional Investor Waiver Application ("Waiver Application") may be submitted for each Principal Entity that is an owner of an Applicant for a sports wagering license and that meets the definition of Institutional Investor in the COMAR 36.10.01.
- **B.2** This Waiver Application must be submitted to the Commission **electronically** via the 'eLicensing' system. Paper applications for Waiver Application <u>will not</u> be accepted by the Commission.
- **B.3** Read each question carefully. Answer each and every question completely. **Do not leave blank** spaces.
- **B.4** Do not misstate or omit any material fact(s). All information is subject to verification. False or misleading information is grounds for the Commission to deny the Waiver Application, deny the Applicant's sports wagering license application, or to suspend or revoke the Applicant's license.
- **B.5** All required documentation, for this Waiver Application <u>must</u> be uploaded into 'eLicensing' on the Applicant Case Checklist Item page at the time of submitting this Waiver Application.
- **B.6** The Institutional Investor should clearly identify those portions of its Waiver Application that it deems to be confidential, proprietary commercial information, trade secrets, or confidential financial information of the Institutional Investor or an individual associated with the Institutional Investor or Applicant and provide justification of why such materials may not be disclosed by the Commission pursuant to a request made under the Public Information Act ("PIA"), Title 4, Subtitle 3, General Provisions Article, Annotated Code of Maryland ("GP"). An Institutional Investor's blanket statement that its entire Waiver Application is "confidential" is unacceptable. Confidential information supplied

by the Institutional Investor shall be used in the ordinary course of processing an Applicant's application and evaluating the qualifications of an Applicant.

Waiver Applications may be subject to partial disclosure pursuant to a request under the PIA. When the Commission receives a PIA request, Staff will collect and review all records that are responsive to the request. The Commission will notify the Institutional Investor and Applicant of a request made under the PIA and will consider the Institutional Investor and Applicant's views as to whether the requested information is exempt from disclosure under the PIA. The Commission will make a determination as to whether the information may be disclosed.

B.7 The Commission may request additional financial and other information as needed.

As a representative, I have the right to request a complete and accurate disclosure of the nature and scope of the investigation and a copy of a summary of the Institutional Investor's rights under federal credit reporting law.

I am requesting that the Commission, through its employees, agents or vendors, obtain this information about the Institutional Investor to evaluate the Applicant's eligibility for a license. I acknowledge that this disclosure and authorization remain in effect during the time the Applicant's application is pending and during the time of any sports wagering license that may be issued to the Applicant.
