- 2) ITLM net sales in November 2021 (\$1,028,632) was an increase of 37.9% compared to November 2020 (\$746,120).

D Responsible Gambling

- 1) Voluntary Exclusion Program
 - a) 24 new participants joined the casino VEP in November; the current number of active participants is 2,515.
 - b) There were 21 removals from the VEP in November, for a total of 766.
 - c) To date, 1,655 violations have occurred since the casino VEP began. All violators are subject to criminal trespass charges.
 - d) There were 4 additional enrollments in the lottery VEP in November with 3 removals; the total number of participants is 472.
 - e) There are currently 126 participants in the bingo hall VEP.
- 2) Co-hosted an informational webinar on responsible gambling in November with the MD Center of Excellence.
- 3) Reviewed and approved the Sports Wagering Responsible Gaming Plans for the 5 casinos who have submitted their Sports Wagering license applications.
- 4) Preparing responsible gambling initiatives for the implementation of sports wagering.
