Maryland State Department of Assessments and Taxation ("Maryland SDAT") contact information

In order to legally conduct business in Maryland, every vendor is required to register with Maryland SDAT, regardless of the combined annual total.

A Vendor applicant must submit their application to the Commission with their **business name entered exactly as the name appears on the Maryland SDAT certificate**.

Out-of-state Vendors may need to:

- a) Go to the Maryland SDAT web site home page link,
- b) On the top toolbar, click on "Forms"
- c) Scroll down to "FOREIGN (non-Maryland) BUSINESSES", click "Foreign Corporation Qualification Form"
- d) Complete the form with applicable fee(s).

If necessary, contact MD SDAT (410-767-1340/1350) to inquire how they can expedite this process.

Since proof of registration is required for the application process, you are welcome to print a copy or make a .pdf of the 'General Information' page that displays the status and the Maryland SDAT Department ID Number. There will not be a need for you to click on the >>Order Certificate of Status, (unless you need one for your own corporate records). The Commission does not need a \$20 copy of the certificate from Maryland SDAT for the vendor application.

Note: Maryland gaming laws require every approved vendor to maintain compliance with Maryland SDAT regulations. Each vendor must remain in "Good Standing' for the duration of their approval. The Commission may cancel a Vendor's approval if the vendor's Business Charter is forfeited by Maryland SDAT.
