III. SPECIAL PROJECTS

- The department has participated in the Agency's fixed assets system implementation process. This system is expected to not only reduce the length of time to approve Agency procurement requests but also to allow for real time status of such requests. Additionally, it is expected that the inventory control module will create efficiencies in entries of, maintenance of and reconciliation of inventory records. The Accounting department is participating in the testing of the system.
- The department's Special Projects Manager is a loaned executive for the 2022 Maryland Charity Campaign which will launch in October 2022. This is the 2nd year for this manager's participation.

IV. FANTASY COMPETITIONS OPERATORS

• The quarterly tax revenue forms and payments for the tax period of April 1, 2022 through June 30, 2022 were due on July 15, 2022. For this period, the Agency collected \$395,687.

V. <u>LOTTERY RETATILER INCENTIVES</u>

• For FY 2022, lottery retailers received \$1,320,477.48 in retailer incentives.
