Subtitle 02 LOTTERY PROVISIONS

Chapter 01 General

Authority: State Government Article, §§9-103, 9-104, 9-109—9-111, and 9-122, Annotated Code of Maryland

.01 Definitions.

- B. Terms Defined.
 - (1) "Activate" means to make an in-lane ticket or a book of instant tickets ready for sale.
- (2) "Announced end of game" means the date determined and announced by the Agency after which [retailers] *a retailer* may not activate *an* instant ticket game [books.] *book*.
 - (3) (4) (text unchanged)
 - (5) Cash.
- (a) "Cash" means [coins,] U.S. currency or coin, or a money [orders,] order, debit [cards, and checks] card, check, and Maryland Lottery pre-paid gift card.
 - (b) (text unchanged)
 - (6) (7) (text unchanged)
- (8) "Daily game" means a draw game for which the Agency offers a drawing at least once every day.
 - (9) (text unchanged)
 - (10) Draw Game.
- (a) "Draw game" means a lottery game_where a winning result is determined by a drawing for which a ticket:
- (i) [Sold] *Is sold* and redeemed through a subscription or a computer network [at] *by a* retailer [locations]; and
- (ii) [tickets are] May be generated by a terminal and [are] is a record of a transaction for a draw game.

- (b) "Draw game" includes:
 - (i) A jackpot game including multi-jurisdictional jackpot games;
 - (ii) A nonjackpot game including multi-jurisdictional nonjackpot games;
 - (iii) A monitor game; and
 - [(iv) A multi-jurisdictional game played with draw game tickets; and]
 - [(v)] (iv)Any other Agency-issued game played as described in this section.
- (11) "Draw ticket" or "Draw game ticket" means a ticket purchased [from a terminal or through a subscription.]:
 - (a) From a Lottery terminal;
 - (b) Through a subscription; or
 - (c) If an in-lane ticket, from a device that is not a lottery terminal.
 - (12) (13) (text unchanged).
- (14) "ePlayslip" means [an electronically-generated game play selection process using an official web or mobile application issued by the Agency that is used by a player to select the purchaser's playable numbers.] an on-screen display or two-dimensional code, that:
 - (a) Contains player-selected game data; and
 - (b) Is electronically generated by a Lottery-authorized web or mobile application.
 - (15) Fast Play Game.
- (a) "Fast Play game" means a game produced by a lottery terminal where predetermined game results are obtained from a finite pool of randomly generated results for that specific game [and are printed on a ticket] and are available through the ticket.
- (b) "Fast Play game" does not include [games where players select their numbers or symbols; and there is a drawing to determine a winning number or symbol.] a draw game.
 - (16) "In-lane ticket" means a lottery ticket that:
 - (a) Is purchased by player in person;
- (b) Is purchased, activated and processed through a Lottery-authorized device or system that is not a lottery terminal; and

- (c) Is valid only when processed through a Lottery authorized device.
- [(16)] (17) ["Instant game["] or ["]instant ticket game["].
- (a) "Instant game" or "instant ticket game" means a lottery game where tickets have an area that the player exposes in accordance with the game instructions, and includes:
 - [(a)] (i) Scratch-off tickets; and
- [(b)] (ii) Tickets using other methods of revealing a hidden area with pre-determined results.
 - (b) "Instant game" or "instant ticket game" does not include an in-lane ticket for a draw game.
- [(17)] (18) "Instant ticket" or "instant game ticket" means an authorized lottery *instant* game ticket issued in [an instant game] *an instant ticket pack*.
- [(18)] (19) "Instant ticket pack" or "instant ticket book" means [a group of sequential instant tickets that are in an individual bundle.] instant tickets in sequential order bundled together.
- [(19)] (20) "Jackpot game" means a lottery game where the top prize amount varies [depending on amounts wagered and on] based on sales and whether the top prize was won in the preceding drawing.
- [(20)] (21) ["Lottery game" means a game, activity, or other enterprise offered by the Agency for consideration to win a prize by random chance and, unless specified by the Director, does not include a promotional game.]

Lottery game.

- (a) "Lottery game" means a game, activity, or other enterprise offered by the Agency for consideration to win a prize by lot or chance in which:
 - (i) The only direct or personal participation by the player is the player's purchase of a ticket or its equivalent;
 - (ii) The player need not be present during the drawing, when the game ends, or when the results become known;
 - (iii) The chance to win is determined at random; and
 - (iv) The profits made are for the benefit of the State.
 - (b) "Lottery game" does not include:

- (i) A fantasy competition under State Government Article § 9-1D, Annotated Code of Maryland; or
 - (ii) Unless otherwise specified by the Director, a promotional game.
- [(21)] (22) "Monitor" means a television screen or similar type of screen used to display [draw] *monitor* game results.
 - [(22)] (23) "Monitor game" means a draw game where:
 - (a) Tickets are generated by [an Agency vendor's computer] a terminal;
 - (b) An Agency vendor's computer generates results [of the draw game]; and
 - (c) Drawing results may be graphically displayed on a monitor.
 - [(23)] (24) "Multi-jurisdictional game" means a lottery game offered by the Agency and:
 - (a) Any other political entity outside Maryland or outside the United States;
 - (b) Any private licensee of a state or a foreign nation; or
 - (c) Both.
 - [(24)] (25) "Nonjackpot game" means a lottery game where the top prize remains constant.
- [(25)] (26) "Number" means any item or symbol used to play to win a lottery game, including:
 - (a) Numerals;
 - (b) Letters; [and]
 - (c) Symbols; and
 - [(c)] (d) Icons including branded marks and logos.
- [(26)] (27) "Odds" means the long run ratio of the number of times a win does not occur to the number of times a win does occur.
 - [(27)] (28) "Pari-mutuel" means:
- (a) The total number of winning matches *for an individual* prize level, divided equally into the dollar value of the prize pool for the specific prize level; or

- (b) The total number of winning matches [in the] *across* designated prize levels, divided equally into the dollar value of the prize pool for the designated prize levels.
 - [(28)] (29) Player-Activated Terminal or PAT.
- (a) "Player-activated terminal" or "PAT" means a machine through which a player may purchase [Agency tickets] a Lottery ticket or claim a prize without action by [a licensed retailer] another individual.
 - (b) (text unchanged)
- [(29)] (30) "Playslip" means a [card] paper form issued by the Agency and used by a player to select the purchaser's [playable numbers] game data.
 - [(30)] (31) [33] (34) (text unchanged)
- [(34)] (35) "Subscription" means a method of playing a lottery game which [provides the ability] *allows a player* to play a specific number of games using the same numbers for a period of consecutive drawings as specified on the subscription [membership card] *application*.
- [(35)] (36) "Terminal" means [a computerized unit specifically designed for issuing and processing tickets and for printing special reports.] a computerized unit specifically designed for:
 - (a) Issuing and processing:
 - (i) ePlayslips;
 - (ii) Playslips;
 - (iii) Tickets; and
- (b) Printing special reports.
- [(36)] (37) "Validate" or "validation" means the process of [determining that a ticket is the rightful winner so that the claimant may be paid the prize] verifying, through a terminal, whether a ticket is a winning ticket.
