These proposed amendments would codify the Agency's practice of recognizing and licensing two Tiers of contractors based on the services they actually perform for a casino, based on their access to the casino's essential functions; fees are lower for contractors with less access. These proposed amendments are consistent with the contractor licensing requirements in the sports wagering regulations at COMAR 36.10.01.02 and 36.10.06.04.

## 12 .14 Contractor Licenses.

A. General. If a video lottery operation licensee engages a <u>Tier 1 or Tier 2</u> contractor to
provide services described in COMAR 36.03.01.02B(1) <u>or (2)</u>, the contractor shall qualify under
the standards and provisions set forth in State Government Article, §§9-1A-07 and 9-1A-08,
Annotated Code of Maryland.

B. Qualification Requirements. The Commission may issue a <u>Tier 1 or Tier 2</u> contractor
license to a [contractor that]person or individual who has provided the Commission with
sufficient information to establish by clear and convincing evidence that it:

(1) Is qualified under State Government Article, §9-1A-07(c), Annotated Code of Maryland;
 and

(2) Has not been disqualified under State Government Article, §9-1A-08, Annotated Code ofMaryland.
