Skills-Based Amusement Device Standards

Please read the information below, and check your machines to ensure they are in compliance with Code of Maryland Regulation <u>36.08.01</u>, <u>36.08.03</u>, and <u>36.08.04</u>.

LAWFUL Skills-Based Amusement Devices

Devices that are registered with Maryland Lottery and Gaming with an outcome based on player skill. These offer non-cash prizes with a wholesale value of \$30.00 or less.

UNLAWFULSkills-Based Amusement Devices

- Prizes awarded per play exceed minimal value (\$30.00).
- Devices award cash prizes or prizes readily convertible to cash.
- Outcome of games are determined by chance.
- Ability of players to succeed is impacted by the number or ratio of prior wins/losses on the device.
- Outcome of games can be determined by sources other than player.
- Success of player is determined by chance event(s) outside players' control.
- Ability of players to succeed is impacted by game features not known or visible to a reasonable player.
- Ability of players to succeed is impacted by an exercise of skill no reasonable player could exercise.

Skill = a learned ability of doing a thing competently; a particular ability, strategy, or tactic; a coordinated set of actions; dexterity, fluency, or coordination in executing physical or mental tasks; technical proficiency or expertise; development of a strategy or tactic to achieve a goal; and/or knowledge of the means of completing a task.
