Following is a status update of ongoing and special projects in the Communications Division:

MEDIA RELATIONS

News Coverage:

More than 50 articles and/or segments on the Maryland Lottery, Maryland's casinos, and/or Maryland's sports wagering program were broadcast and/or published online in the past month by local/regional/industry media including WMAR-TV, Fox 45 and WTOP Radio in Baltimore; Fox 5 and WTOP Radio in Washington, D.C.; the Maryland Daily Record, the Baltimore Business Journal, the Baltimore Sun, the Hagerstown Herald-Mail and the Salisbury Times.

Broadcast Opportunities:

Communications staff members conducted outreach to broadcast outlets to discuss the Thanks for Playing Promotion, which awarded more than 15,000 cash vouchers worth a total of more than \$1 million to Lottery customers on May 24, commemorating the 50th anniversary date of the Lottery's first drawing. Staff members did 10 radio interviews and two TV interviews from 5/22 through 5/24:

- Doug Lloyd: Fox 5 in Washington, D.C., and WSMD Radio on 5/22; Fox 45 on 5/23; WBAL Radio on 5/24; and a recorded interview with WTOP that was broadcast on 5/24
- Gail Pelovitz: WAFY in Frederick and WQCM in Hagerstown on 5/22; WFRE in Frederick on 5/23; and WLIF in Baltimore on 5/24
- Roslyn Lane: WMMX in Baltimore on 5/23; and WZBA in Baltimore on 5/24
- Brandon Powell: Recorded interview on 5/24 that was broadcast on Salisbury radio stations WBOC, WRDE and WZBH

Director Martin did an interview with Stan "The Fan" Charles on Pressbox Live on 5/18 to discuss the state's sports wagering market and the Lottery's 50th anniversary. Director Martin and other Lottery staff are also continuing a series of weekly video conference interviews with Nestor Aparicio for WNST/baltimorepositive.com. The recorded segments are available each Friday.

Winner Interviews, Stories and Lottery News Releases:

Communications staff members conduct interviews with winners of \$30,000 or more who claim their prizes at the Lottery's office. Winners may remain anonymous, but stories include names or photos of winners who give written consent for publicity regarding their prizes. Winner and other lottery-related stories are published on *mdlottery.com*.

Each Monday (or the following day if Monday is a holiday) the Communications staff issues a news release, "The Week in Winners," listing Lottery tickets worth \$10,000 or more that were sold or redeemed in the preceding seven days.

Casino and Sports Wagering Information and News Releases:

Communications staff members write and issue monthly revenue reports on Maryland's casino and sports wagering programs. Information is also regularly posted in the casino and sports wagering sections of *mdgaming.com*.

Communications issued the following casino and gaming news releases in the past month:
