IV. SPECIAL PROJECTS

- The Sports Entertainment Facilities and Events, Prince George’s County Blue Line Corridor Facilities, and Racing Facilities Act (the “Sports Entertainment Facilities Act”) was enacted as Chapter 61 (HB 897) of the Acts of 2022, and amended by Chapter 468 (SB 442) of the Acts of 2023 (the “Amendment” and with the Sports Entertainment Facilities Act, the “Act”) by the Maryland General Assembly. Subject to the terms and conditions set forth in the Act, the Maryland Stadium Authority (the “Authority”) is authorized to issue up to \$220 million in bonds to finance the design, construction, equipping, and furnishing of any segment of a Sports Entertainment Facility (a “Sports Entertainment Facility”) as defined in the Act. Because the capital improvements projects will be funded by lottery revenues, the Maryland Lottery & Gaming Control Agency is assisting the Maryland Stadium Authority in the debt service preparations.
