9 10 11	A. Scope. This chapter establishes a mechanism by which an individual may request to be placed on the Commission's Voluntary Exclusion List of individuals with gambling problems who have requested to self-exclude themselves from [:
12	(1) Video lottery facilities in the State;
13	(2) Lottery play in the State;
14	(3) Instant bingo facilities under COMAR 36.07 with more than 10 instant bingo machines;
15 16	(4) Participating in fantasy competitions offered by fantasy competition operators registered under COMAR 36.09;
17	(5) Participating in sports wagering offered by a sports wagering licensee; or
18 19	(6) Any combination of the five.] a gaming activity or a combination of multiple gaming activities.
20	B. Definitions.
21 22	(1) Unless context or [the individual] regulation dictates otherwise, in this chapter the following terms have the meanings indicated.
23	(2) Terms Defined.
24 25	(a) "Affiliated entity" means an entity sharing ownership or management with a licensee of a gaming activity.
26 27 28 29	[(a)] (b) "Commission's Voluntary Exclusion List" means the list established by the Commission [as a measure to reduce or mitigate the effects of problem gambling] that allows [individuals with gambling problems] an individual to request to be excluded from participating in certain [lottery and gambling] gaming activities for a specified period of time.
30 31 32	[(b) "Direct exclusion" means the ability of a person to make a request directly to a fantasy sports competition operator or a sports wagering licensee for exclusion from their online services.]
33	(c) "Sports wagering licensee" means:
34	(i) Sports wagering facility licensee;
35	(ii) Mobile sports wagering licensee;

1	(iii) Sports wagering facility operator licensee; and
2	(iv) Online sports wagering operator licensee.
3	C. The Commission shall:
4 5	(1) Maintain the Commission's Voluntary Exclusion List for individuals who have requested to be excluded from a gaming activity; and [÷
6	(a) Video lottery facilities
7	(b) Lottery play in the State;
8	(c) Instant bingo facilities with more than 10 instant bingo machines;
9	(d)Fantasy competitions offered by registered fantasy competition operators; or
10	(e) Participating in sports wagering offered by sports wagering licensees; and]
11	(2) Establish measures to reduce and mitigate the effects of problem gambling.
12 13	.02 Application for Placement on the Commission's Voluntary Exclusion List.
14 15	A. An <u>individual may obtain an application</u> for placement on the Commission's Voluntary Exclusion List [shall be available through] by:
16 17	(1) [Each]Contacting a licensed video lottery facility [upon request to] and requesting an application from Commission staff;
18 19 20	(2) [Each] Contacting a licensed instant bingo facility with more than 10 instant bingo machines and requesting an application that is solely for exclusion from a licensed instant bingo facility; [and]
21	(3) [The] Contacting the Agency[.]; or
22	(4) Obtaining an application online.
23 24	B. Information about [applications]an application for placement on the Commission's Voluntary Exclusion List shall be available [through] at:
25	(1) Each licensed video lottery facility;
26	(2) Each registered fantasy competition operator;
27	(3) Each sports wagering licensee;
28	(4) Each licensed instant bingo facility with more than 10 instant bingo machines; and
29	(5) The Agency.
30	C. An individual may request to be excluded from:

2 3	by submitting a completed application for placement on the Commission's Voluntary Exclusion List to [Commission] Agency staff; and
4 5	(2) An instant bingo facility with more than 10 instant bingo machines by submitting a completed application [form] to instant bingo facility staff.
6 7	D. [An] A completed application for placement on the Commission's Voluntary Exclusion List shall include:
8 9	(1) Sufficient information and documentation to identify [and], exclude [the individual], and contact the individual;
10 11	(2) A signature of the individual, which may include the use of a Commission-approved secure electronic means; and
12	(3) Any other information about the individual that the Commission requires.

14	[(a)] (1) Name, including any nickname or alias;

29 30	(2) F. A completed application shall identify [The]the length of time requested for placement on the Commission's Voluntary Exclusion List, which shall be for:

2 3	[(4)] G. In the completed application, an applicant shall acknowledge: [Acknowledgment that]

7 8 9	(a) Has a gambling problem and is unable to gamble responsibly;] (2) The applicant is knowingly and voluntarily applying for inclusion on the Commission's Voluntary Exclusion List;
10	[(b)] (3) Is sober and informed;
11 12 13 14	[(e)Releases] (4) That the applicant releases and holds harmless the State of Maryland, the Commission, the Agency, and their members, employees, and agents from any liability that may arise from the application or the individual's placement on the Commission's Voluntary Exclusion List;
15 16	[(d) Acknowledges that] (5) That the Commission is collecting information from the individual that the:
17 18	[(i)] (a) Individual may request to inspect or correct under General Provisions Article, §4-502, Annotated Code of Maryland;
19 20	[(ii)] (b) Commission will maintain as sociological information under General Provisions Article, §4-330, Annotated Code of Maryland; and
21 22	[(iii)] (c) Commission or its licensees may share with entities as provided in Regulation .05 of this chapter;
23 24	[(e) Authorizes] (6) That the release of information to the persons specified in Regulation .07 of this chapter is permitted;
25 26 27	[(f) Acknowledges that the individual will be, for] (7) For the entire term of the requested period of exclusion the individual will be prohibited from participating in each gaming activity selected; [:
28 29	(i) Prohibited from entering a video lottery facility and playing table games or a video lottery terminal;
30	(ii) Prohibited from playing a lottery game;
31 32	(iii) Prohibited from playing an instant bingo machine at an instant bingo facility with more than 10 instant bingo machines;

10 11	(h) Acknowledges that] (9) That the individual may be subject to criminal charges if, during the period of exclusion, the individual enters a video lottery facility in the State;

31	[(k) Is] (13) That the individual is voluntarily applying.
32 33	[E.] <u>H.</u> Upon receipt of a completed application for placement on the Commission's Voluntary Exclusion List, assigned [Commission] <u>Agency</u> staff may:
34	(1) Interview the individual in order to [ascertain that the individual] confirm that the:
35	(a) [Is] Individual is voluntarily applying for exclusion;
36	(b) [Is] Individual is sober and informed;

1 2	(c) [Confirms the information] Information provided in the application is accurate and complete; and

27 28 29	(d) Notice that the individual may be unable to participate in sports wagering offered by a sports wagering facility operator or online sports wagering operator affiliated with a video lotter facility.
30 31 32 33	(2) The Agency's notice of an individual's placement on the Commission's Voluntary Exclusion List for exclusion from participating in fantasy competitions in the State shall include notice that the individual may be excluded from participating in fantasy competitions offered by fantasy competition operators in another jurisdiction;
34 35	(3) The Agency's notice of an individual's placement on the Commission's Voluntary Exclusion List for exclusion from sports wagering in the State shall include:

1 2	(a) Notice that the individual is not permitted in the sports wagering-related areas of a sports wagering facility;
3 4 5	(b) Notice that the individual may be excluded from participating in sports wagering offered by a sports wagering licensee in any of its affiliated facilities or platforms in other jurisdictions; and
6 7	(e) (4) Notice that, if the individual enters a video lottery facility that offers sports wagering, the individual may be subject to criminal charges.
8 9	.03 Direct Exclusion by Operator.
10	A. Registered Fantasy Competition Operator.
11 12 13	(1) A registered fantasy competition operator may, on request of an individual, directly exclude the individual from participating in [fantasy competitions] a fantasy competition through its platform.
14	(2) A request for direct exclusion from a fantasy competition operator's platform:
15 16	(a) Is not an application for placement on the Commission's Voluntary Exclusion List under this chapter;
17	(b) Will not result in placement on the Commission's Voluntary Exclusion List;
18	(c) Is not a record that is maintained by the Commission; and
19 20	(d) Does not prevent the person from using another fantasy competition platform in Maryland.
21	B. Mobile Sports Wagering Licensee.
22 23 24 25	(1) [A] An individual may request direct exclusion from a mobile sports wagering [licensee through its sports wagering platform or its online sports wagering operator's platform may, on request of an individual, directly exclude the individual from participating in sports wagering on its platform] platform.
26 27	(2) A request for direct exclusion from a mobile sports wagering [licensee's] platform [operated by its online sports wagering operator]:
28	(a) Is not an application for placement on the Commission's Voluntary Exclusion List;
29	(b) Will not result in inclusion on the Commission's Voluntary Exclusion List;
30	(c) Is not a record that is maintained by the Commission; and
31 32	(d) Does not prevent the [person]individual from using another mobile sports wagering platform in Maryland.
33 34	.04 Voluntary Surrender.

1	A. In this regulation, the following term has the meaning indicated.
2	B. Term Defined. "Unredeemed item":
3 4	(1) Means a token, voucher, check, ticket, chip, coupon, <u>points</u> , or similar item that has monetary value, and that a player has [÷

21	(2) Does not include cash.
22 23	C. An individual who applies to be placed on the Commission's Voluntary Exclusion List contractually agrees to:
24	(1) Redeem or liquidate an unredeemed item with monetary value that the individual has:
25 26	(a) In their possession since being placed on the Commission's Voluntary Exclusion List or
27 28	(b) Received from a fantasy competition, if the individual entered the fantasy competition after placement on the Commission's Voluntary Exclusion List; and
29 30 31	(2) Designate that the proceeds of the item be redeemed and [contributed] distributed to the Problem Gambling Fund established under State Government Article, §9-1A-33(b), Annotated Code of Maryland.
32 33	.05 The Commission's Voluntary Exclusion List.

- 28 A. After an individual has been on the Commission's Voluntary Exclusion List for at least 2
- 29 years, the individual may request that the Commission remove the individual from the list.

- 31 Commission accompanied by documentation that the individual has:

- 33 (a) A problem gambling treatment or prevention program approved by the Commission;

25	.08 Responsible Gaming Program.
26	A. The Commission may establish a responsible gaming program.
27 28	B. A responsible gaming program established by the Commission under §A of this regulation shall be designed to:
29	(1) Reduce or mitigate the effects of problem gambling in the State; and
30 31	(2) Maximize the access of [individuals who have a gambling problem to] problem gambling resources by an individual who has a gambling problem.
