- 1) ITLM Update - As of 4/7/2025, 401 ITLMs in 90 unique Veterans’ Posts are currently operational.
- 2) Monthly ITLM net sales in March 2025 (\$1,607,129) increased by 3.1% compared to March 2024 (\$1,558,588).
- 3) MGM National Harbor Casino submitted a request to remove the Noodle Bar, located adjacent to Pit 14 on the gaming floor, and install 48 VLTs in the space and remove 14 VLTs, for a net increase of 34. IGT is prepared to support this request and has the site prepped. MGM National Harbor Casino will adhere to the standard change request protocol for the installation of the VLTs and submit updated floor plans for approval. Renovations are scheduled to start in early April 2025.

E Responsible Gambling

- 1) Voluntary Exclusion Program (VEP)
 - a) 44 new participants joined the casino VEP in March. The current number of active participants is 3,310.
 - b) There were 14 removals from the VEP in March for a total of 1,442.
 - c) To date, 2,980 violations have occurred since the casino VEP began. All violators are subject to criminal trespass charges.
 - d) There were 15 additional enrollments in the lottery VEP in March with 3 removals; the total number of participants is 792.
 - e) There are currently 640 participants in the bingo hall VEP.
 - f) There are currently 482 participants in the sports wagering VEP.
 - g) There are currently 447 participants in the fantasy competition VEP.
