SUBJECT: Summary of recent and upcoming tasks

The legal advice and counsel that our AAGs provide is generally considered confidential and legally privileged, so we cannot provide specific details about our work in this publicly available Memorandum. However, we strive to provide updates on special projects or notable issues for which our Unit has recently provided, or anticipates providing, legal support:

- Received a decision from the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) upholding the Agency's recommended denial of a gaming manufacturer license
- Received a decision from the OAH granting several sports wagering employee licensees' motions to stay hearings on the recommended revocations of their licenses
- During the General Assembly session, assisted Staff review bills with potential impact on the Agency/Commission; for enrolled bills that take effect, assist Agency Staff work through any necessary regulation amendments and operational issues
- Support the Agency's procurement processes, including contract matters Staff presents to the Commission
- Assist Staff as needed with the Agency's efforts to address unauthorized gaming activity in the State
