12 13 14	B. Except for funds held in the reserve account that exceed the licensee's reserve requirement specified in §C of this regulation, Aa sports wagering licensee may not remove, release, or withdraw funds from its reserve without the written approval of the Commission.
15 16	C. The amount in the reserve shall be at least \$500,000 and equal or exceed the aggregate sum of:
17 18	(1) The total amount of funds to cover the potential liability for all wagers accepted by the sports wagering licensee on sporting events with outcomes that have not been determined; and
19	(2) Money owed but unpaid by the sports wagering licensee to bettors on winning wagers.
