#### V. SPECIAL PROJECTS

The Maryland Stadium Authority – Increase of Bond Authorization – Camden Yards was enacted as Chapter 60 (HB 896) of the Acts of 2022 by the Maryland General Assembly. Subject to terms and conditions set forth, the Maryland Stadium Authority ("the Authority") is authorized to increase the cap on Camden Yard Sports Complex debt (\$600 million each for the sports facilities at Camden Yards, including Oriole Park at Camden Yards and M&T Bank Stadium) and to issue bonds to finance the increased debt.

The Authority's Oriole Park Comprehensive Financing Plan – Series 2025B is expected to issue \$187,690,000 bonds and Series 2025C is expected to issue \$10,370,000 bonds for the capital improvement projects of Oriole Park. It was approved by the Authority's Board of Directors on May 6, 2025.

Because the capital improvements projects will be funded by lottery revenues, the Maryland Lottery & Gaming Control Agency assisted the Maryland Stadium Authority in the debt service preparations. The department and other Agency personnel participated in the compilation and review of documents required for the bond offerings; assisted the credit rating agencies in determining of the credit rating for this offering through presentation of various Lottery information to the rating agency personnel; and participated in the due diligence conducted by the Underwriter in connection with the issuance of the bond.
