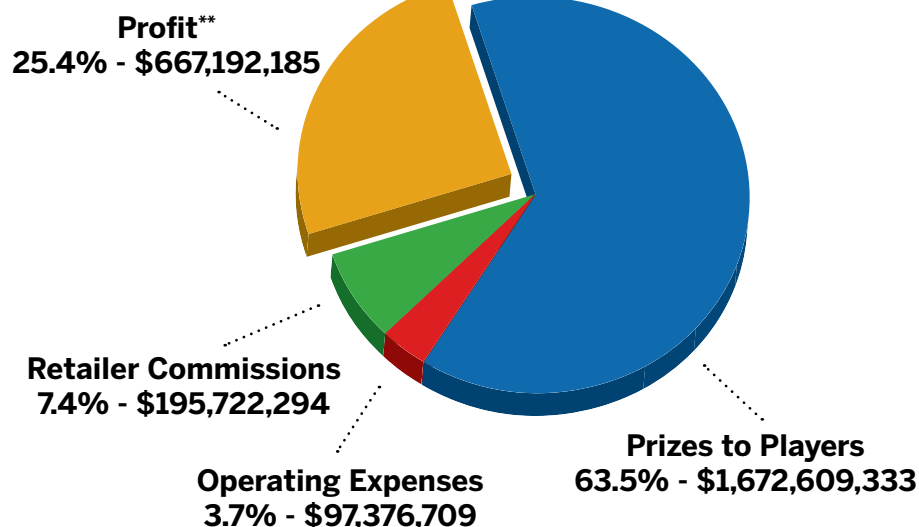

Lottery FY2025 Facts & Figures

The Maryland Lottery continued its growth in FY2025:

- **Profit to the State: \$667.2 Million**
Fifth-best total in the Maryland Lottery's 52-year history
- **Total Sales: \$2.633 Billion**
Fourth-best total in Maryland Lottery history
Scratch-off sales surpassed \$1 Billion for the fourth consecutive year
- **Player Prizes: \$1.673 Billion**
An average of nearly \$4.6 Million per day
1,638 prizes of \$10,000 or more, including 33 prizes of at least \$1 Million
- **Retailer Sales & Cashing Commissions: \$195.7 Million**
Average commissions of more than \$45,000 per retailer

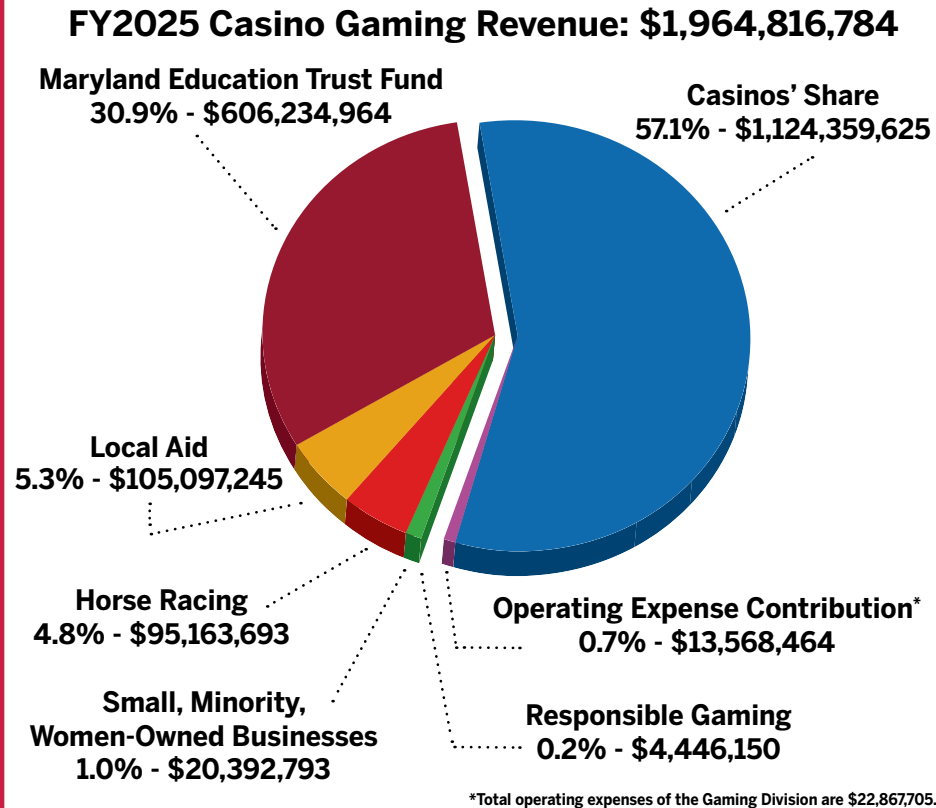
CASINO GAMING FY2025

Casino FY2025 Facts & Figures

Maryland's casinos contribute portions of slot machine and table game revenue to the Maryland Education Trust Fund; local aid for the communities and jurisdictions where the casinos are located; the horse racing industry; and Maryland's Small, Minority and Women-Owned Business Fund.

- **Casino Gaming Revenue: \$1.965 Billion**
Third-best performance in the 15-year history of Maryland's casino program
- **Total Contribution to the State: \$831.3 Million**
Third-best total in casino program history
An increase of more than \$7 Million from FY2024
- **Contribution to the Education Trust Fund: \$606.2 Million**
An increase of more than \$5.5 Million from FY2024
- **Local Aid Contributions: \$105.1 Million**
Includes contributions to local impact grants and casino jurisdictions
- **Horse Racing Contributions: \$95.2 Million**
Includes contributions to Racetrack Facility Renewal and Purse Dedication accounts
- **Small, Minority, and Women-Owned Business Fund Contribution: \$20.4 Million**
A 1.5% increase from FY2024
- **Problem Gambling Fund Contribution: \$4.4 Million**
Casinos pay annual assessments of \$425 per slot machine and \$500 per table game

Sports Wagering Definitions

- **Handle:** Amount players wagered, including promotional wagers provided by sportsbooks
- **Prizes:** Winnings paid to players
- **Hold %:** Percentage of the handle remaining after prizes are paid
- **Other Deductions:** Includes federal excise tax and loss carryforward
- **Taxable Win:** Amount remaining after sportsbooks pay winners and deduct promotional play and other amounts
- **Contributions to the State:** The portion of operators' taxable win that was directed to the Blueprint for Maryland's Future Fund.
- **Promotional Play:** Complimentary play provided to customers by sports wagering operators.

Sports Wagering FY2025 Facts & Figures

- **All mobile and retail operators:** Through May 2025, contribution to the State was 15% of taxable win directed to the Blueprint for Maryland's Future Fund.
- **Mobile operators:** Contribution to the State increased to 20% beginning in June 2025.
 - For June 2025 only, the entire amount was directed to the Blueprint.
 - From July 2025 onward, mobile operators pay 15% to the Blueprint and 5% to the General Fund.
- **Retail operators:** Contribution to the State remains 15% of taxable win directed to the Blueprint.
- Expired/withheld sports wagering prizes paid to the Problem Gambling Fund in FY2025: \$1,329,243.

Fantasy Competition FY2025 Facts & Figures

The operators of fantasy competitions (including daily fantasy sports) contribute 15% of their proceeds to the Blueprint for Maryland's Future Fund. In FY2025, total fantasy competition proceeds were \$6,996,317, distributed as follows:

- Operators' Share: \$5,946,870 (85%)
- Blueprint for Maryland's Future Fund: \$1,049,448 (15%)

Racing and Community Development Facilities Fund Transfers

In FY2025, Maryland Lottery and Gaming received \$5 Million from the Horse Racing Purse Dedication Account, \$3.5 Million from the Pimlico Community Development Authority, and \$10,847,018 from the Racetrack Facility Renewal Account, totaling \$19,374,018. Per the Racing and Community Development Act of 2020, the \$19,374,018 was then allocated as follows: \$17 Million to the Racing and Community Development Facilities Fund and \$2,374,018 to the General Fund.



Maryland Lottery and Gaming encourages responsible gaming. Players must be at least 18 to buy Maryland Lottery tickets or participate in fantasy competitions, and must be at least 21 to gamble at Maryland's casinos or place sports wagers.
