SUBJECT: Summary of recent and upcoming tasks

Our Unit of the Office of the Attorney General is assigned to provide legal advice and counsel to the Maryland Lottery and Gaming Control Agency (Agency), Agency Staff, and the Maryland Lottery and Gaming Control Commission (Commission).

The legal advice and counsel that our AAGs provide is generally considered confidential and legally privileged, so we cannot provide specific details about our work in this publicly available Memorandum. However, we strive to provide updates on special projects or notable issues for which our Unit has recently provided, or anticipates providing, legal support:

- Received a favorable opinion from the Maryland District Court in the *KalshieEX v. John Martin, et al.* case on the Motion for Preliminary Injunction and Temporary Restraining. Kalshi has appealed the decision to the 4th Circuit. The District Court proceedings will be stayed pending the appeal. - The Circuit Court for Anne Arundel County dismissed a former video lottery employee's petition for judicial review of his license revocation
- Assist Staff with proposed regulatory changes
- Support the Agency's procurement processes, including contract matters Staff presents to the Commission
- Assist Staff with licensing-related matters in all of the Agency's regulated gaming activities.
- Assist Staff as needed with the Agency's efforts to address unauthorized gaming activity in the State
