SUBJECT: Report for the November 2025 Commission Meeting

Following is the status update of ongoing efforts in Government Relations, Regulations, and Human Resources for November.

## **I. GOVERNMENT RELATIONS MATTERS**

### Legislative Update

The members of the Maryland legislature convene at Noon on January 14, 2026 for the start of the 448<sup>th</sup> legislative session of the Maryland General Assembly. The Agency has filed the following three (3) departmental bills with the Governor's Legislative Office: (1) *Prohibition on Illegal Gaming*; (2) *Promotional Play - Sports Wagering*; and (3) *Central Collections Unit - Video Lottery Facilities*, and is now waiting on sponsorship determinations for these bills.

## **II. REGULATORY MATTERS**

The Agency is still waiting on the Notice of Proposed Action to be published in the *Maryland Register* for the following amendments which were approved at the August 28<sup>th</sup> Commission meeting.
