Ready, Set, GROW!

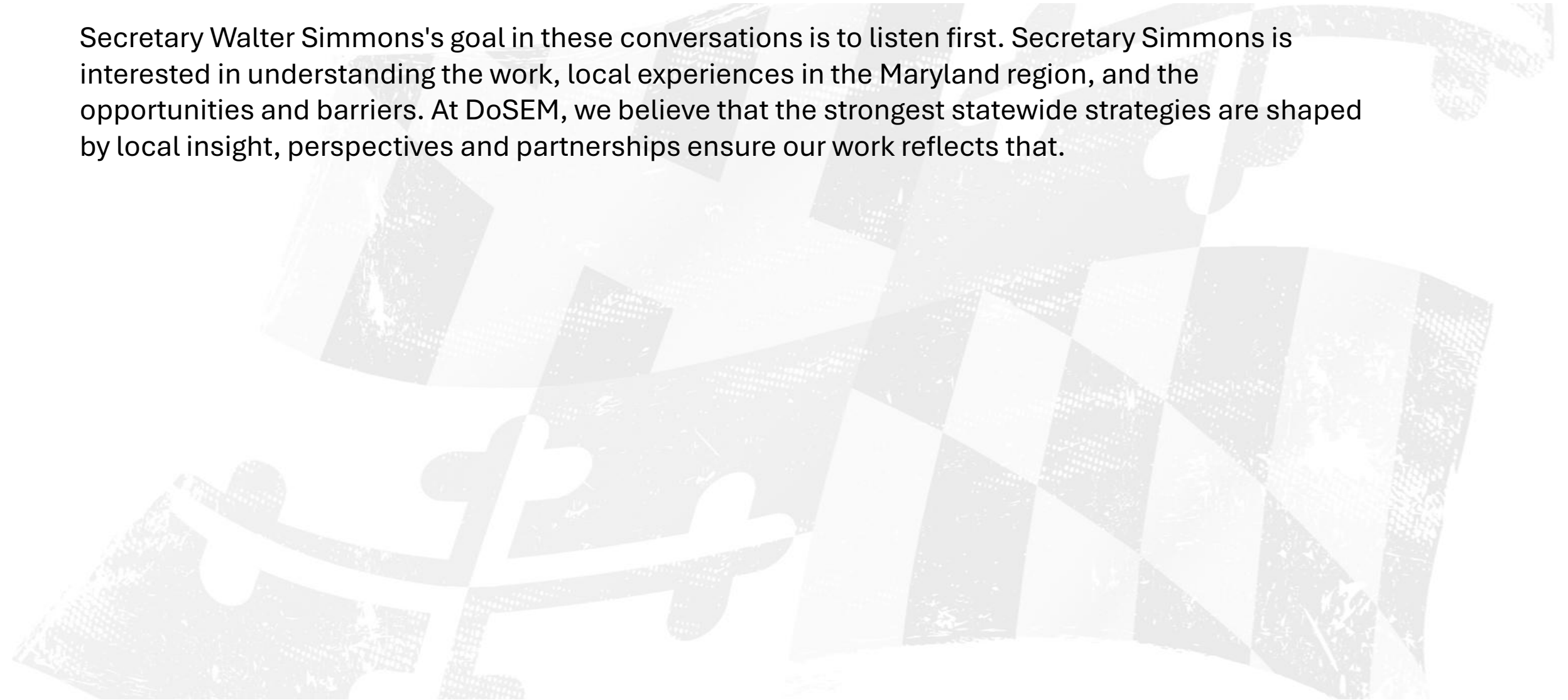

Each agency will share what they are looking to buy currently, what is in their pipeline, and how to connect with them directly. Participants will gain insights on how our small, minority, women, and veteran procurement programs work and learn strategies for mining public data to help with their business development efforts. In addition, the casino that host the event will participate with other state agencies to connect with small, minority, women and veteran businesses.

Voices of Maryland Campaign

The Maryland Department of Social and Economic Mobility's (DoSEM) work centers on how Maryland supports both small and disadvantaged businesses and social equity initiatives across state government. As we prepare recommendations for the Governor and the General Assembly by July 1, the Secretary has made it his highest priority to spend time in every county and Baltimore City, meeting directly with local businesses and economic development leaders.
