The proposed amendments to C(1) would delete the requirement for a driver's license, because not all applicants may have one, and instead required "a valid, government-issued identification"; this also would allow the Agency to accept and consider the application of applicants without regard for country of origin or citizenship. Deleting the requirement for Social Security and telephone numbers would allow the Agency to make these items optional. The proposed amendment to C(2) clarifies that the voluntary exclusion period may actually be more than the selected two-year exclusion period due to the requirements that an individual must satisfy in order to be removed from the VEP list.
