



1 (c) A general cashier to immediately exchange the counter check for:

2 (i) Cash;

3 (ii) If a facility operator has the capability, a gaming ticket; or

4 (iii) A customer deposit account in accordance with this chapter; and

5 (d) A general cashier to distribute the copies of the counter check as follows:

6 (i) The original ~~and redemption copies~~ **copy** of the counter check shall be expeditiously  
7 transferred to the check bank directly or to a security department employee for transportation to  
8 the cashiers' cage if the counter check is issued in a satellite cage;

9 (ii) The issuance copy of the counter check shall be maintained by the general cashier to  
10 serve as documentation supporting the exchange of cash, a gaming ticket, or a customer deposit  
11 for the counter check; and

12 (iii) The accounting copy of the counter check shall be attached by the general cashier to  
13 the counter check request document and forwarded to the accounting department;

15 (9) Details which establish the ability of the facility operator's video lottery system to ensure  
16 that a ~~four~~ **three**-part computer-generated counter check is not susceptible to change or deletion  
17 from the system after preparation; and

18 (10) Procedures utilized to issue a manual counter check which:

19 (a) Are to be utilized only when the video lottery system is unable to generate a counter  
20 check;

21 (b) Conform to the requirements of this regulation;

22 (c) Require use of a serially pre-numbered ~~four~~ **three**-part counter check consisting of an  
23 original, ~~redemption~~, issuance, and accounting copy, residing in a book, wiz machine, or  
24 functional equivalent;

25 (d) Require manual counter checks to be maintained in a secured locked cabinet in the

- 3 for the control of and accounting for the unused supply of counter checks; and
- 4 (ii) Limited to sign out by a cashiers' cage shift manager or cashiers' cage manager.
