7 ~~D. The top or left light of a tower light when viewed from the front of the machine shall be~~

9 ~~ED. The bottom or right light of a tower light when~~ **When illuminated,** ~~viewed from the front~~
10 ~~of a machine~~ **the tower light** shall indicate the default denomination of the video lottery
11 terminal, as follows:

12 ~~(1) Red means a video lottery terminal with a denomination of 10 cents or less;~~

13 ~~(2) Yellow means a video lottery terminal with a denomination of 25 cents;~~

14 ~~(3) Orange means a video lottery terminal with a denomination of 50 cents.~~

15 ~~(4) Blue means a video lottery terminal with a denomination of \$1.~~

16 ~~(5) Pink means a video lottery terminal with a denomination of \$2; and~~

17 ~~(6) Purple means a video lottery terminal with a denomination of \$5 or more.~~

18 **E. Each denomination must be indicated by a unique color and be consistent across the**
19 **facility operator's gaming floor.**
