22 **(a) “Dealer controlled electronic table game” means a table game or table**  
23 **game equipment** that:

24 **(i) requires Requires a live dealer to operate it;**

25 **and (ii) utilizes Utilizes** electronics as part of the games operation to  
26 collect and store game outcome, accounting and other significant event  
27 data; and

28 **(iii) Permits wagering to be conducted electronically at a table game**  
29 **that is operated by a dealer;**
