2 missing or additional cards or any indication of unfair play shall be destroyed or cancelled within  
3 5 7 days of collection.

4 (1) Cards submitted to the Commission shall be destroyed or cancelled within 5 days of  
5 release from the Commission.

6 (2) Destruction of cards must be by shredding.

7 (3) Cancellation of cards must be by drilling a circular hole of at least 1/4 inch in diameter  
8 through the center of each card in the deck.

9 (4) The destruction or cancellation of cards shall take place:

10 (a) [in] In a secure location in the licensed facility covered by the facility operator's  
11 surveillance system, the physical characteristics of which shall be approved by the Commission  
12 under COMAR 36.05.03.16; or

13 (b) If conducted by a vendor that is registered or certified under COMAR 36.03.02.17 and  
14 done in accordance with an internal control of the licensed facility that has been approved by the  
15 Commission under COMAR 36.03.10.05, at a location other than the facility.
