25 D. A table shall have a drop box and a tip box attached on the same side of the gaming table as,
26 but on opposite sides of, the dealer, as approved by the Commission.

27 E. The Commission may approve an alternative location for the tip box when a card shuffling
28 device or other table game equipment prevents the placement of the drop box and tip box on the
29 same side of the gaming table as, but on opposite sides of, the dealer.

30 F. Each table shall have a discard rack securely attached to the top of the dealer’s side of the
31 table except for:

32 (1) Craps; and

33 (2) Roulette.

These amendments are part of the package of proposed amendments to, and repeal of, certain table game regulations that would allow the Commission to more quickly authorize changes to table game rules. Regulations that contain specific game rules would be repealed, and those repealed regulations would remain in the non-regulatory standard rules. Future table game rule changes and the approval of new games would generally not go through the regulatory process.

This all-new regulation contains general requirements for table game tables.
