6 **Chapter .19 Double Draw Poker**

10 **.02 Double Draw Poker Tables.**

11 A. Double Draw Poker shall be played on a table that has:

- 12 (1) Betting positions for no more than six players on one side of the table; and
13 (2) A place for the dealer on the opposite side of the table.

14 B. A facility operator shall submit to the Commission for approval the layout for a
15 Double Draw Poker table that contains, at a minimum:

- 16 (1) The name or logo of the facility operator;
17 (2) Four separate designated betting areas at each player position for the
18 placement of the Ante Wager, Bonus Wager, First Draw Wager, and Second
19 Draw Wager;
20 (3) A separate designated area for the placement of the player's discarded
21 cards;
22 (4) An inscription that advises a player of the payout odds or amounts for all
23 permissible wagers offered by the facility operator;

1 (5) An inscription that advises a player a joker may be used as an ace or to
2 complete any straight or flush;

3 (6) Inscriptions that advise players of the payout limit per hand established by
4 the facility operator under Regulation .12 of this chapter; and

5 (7) If the payout odds or amounts, advice pertaining to use of a joker, or payout
6 limits required under §B(4), (5) and (6) of this regulation are not inscribed on
7 the layout, a sign identifying the payout odds or amounts, advice pertaining to
8 use of a joker, or payout limits shall be posted at each Double Draw Poker
9 table.

10 C. A Double Draw Poker table shall have a drop box and a tip box attached on the
11 same side of the table as, but on opposite sides of the dealer as approved by the
12 Commission under COMAR 36.05.03.16.

13 D. When a card shuffling device or other table game equipment prevents the
14 placement of the drop box and tip box on the same side of the gaming table as, but on
15 opposite sides of, the dealer, the Commission may approve an alternative location for
16 the tip box from the location required under §D of this regulation.

17 E. Each Double Draw Poker table shall have a discard rack securely attached to the
18 top of the dealer's side of the table.
