11 **.07 Wagers.**

12 A. A player shall make a wager at Double Draw Poker by placing a value chip,
13 plaque, or other Commission-approved table game wagering instrument on the
14 appropriate areas of the table layout.

15 B. Placing Wagers.

16 (1) Only a player who is seated at a Double Draw Poker table may wager at the
17 game.

18 (2) After a player has placed a wager and received cards, the player shall
19 remain seated until the completion of the round of play.

20 (3) If a player leaves the table during a round of play, any wagers made by the
21 player may be considered abandoned and may be treated as a losing wager.

22 C. All wagers at Double Draw Poker shall be placed prior to the dealer announcing
23 “no more bets” in accordance with the dealing procedures in Regulations .08—.10 of
24 this chapter.

This regulation is part of the all-new chapter of regulations for Double Draw Poker.

1 D. Except as provided in Regulation .11 of this chapter, a wager may not be made,
2 increased or withdrawn after the dealer has announced “no more bets”.

3 E. Double Draw Poker Wagers.

4 (1) A player competes solely against the posted payable by placing an Ante Wager
5 and Bonus Wager of equal amounts, in accordance with Regulation .11 of this
6 chapter;

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8 (2) To continue, a player shall place the First Draw Wager, equal to the Ante
9 Wager, in accordance with Regulation .11 of this chapter.

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11 (3) To continue, a player shall place the Second Draw Wager, equal to the Ante
12 Wager, in accordance with Regulation .11 of this chapter.
