11 **.10 Procedures for Dealing Cards from an Automated Dealing Shoe**

12 A. Requirements. If the cards are dealt from an automated dealing shoe, the  
13 following requirements shall be met:

14 (1) After the procedures required under Regulation .05 of this chapter have been  
15 completed, the cards shall be placed in the automated dealing shoe.

16 (2) Prior to the dealing shoe dispensing any stacks, the dealer shall announce “no  
17 more bets”.

18 B. The dealer shall:

20 (1) Starting with the player farthest to the dealer’s left and continuing around the  
21 table in a clockwise manner, deal a stack of five cards dispensed from the  
22 automated dealing shoe or shuffler to each player who has placed a wager in  
23 accordance with Regulation .11 of this chapter; and

24 (2) After each stack of five cards has been dispensed and delivered:

25 (a) Remove the stub from the automated dealing shoe; and

1 (b) Except as provided in §C of this regulation, place the cards in the discard  
2 rack without exposing the cards.

3 C. Determining the Number of Cards.

4 (1) If the count of the stub indicates that 54 cards are in the deck, the dealer  
5 shall place the stub in the discard rack without exposing the cards.

6 (2) If the count of the stub indicates that the number of cards in the deck is  
7 incorrect, the dealer shall determine if the cards were misdealt.

8 (3) If 54 cards remain in the deck but the cards were misdealt so that a player  
9 has more or less than 5 cards, all hands are void and the dealer shall return all  
10 wagers to the players.

11 (4) If the cards were not misdealt, all hands are void and the dealer shall return  
12 all wagers to the players and remove the entire deck of cards from the table.
