5                   **Chapter 02 Lawful and Unlawful Electronic Gaming Devices**

7                   Authority: Criminal Law Article §§ 12-301 – 12-308, Annotated Code of Maryland

8                   **.01 Lawful Electronic Gaming Devices.**

9                   An electronic device is lawful if it is:

- 10                  A. An antique electronic gaming device that is not operated for gambling purposes.
- 11                  B. An electronic gaming device that is in the possession of or being transported by a person to  
12                  demonstrate or sell the electronic gaming device to a prospective customer who is allowed to  
13                  purchase an electronic gaming device if the person:
- 14                  (1) Operates with or under a distributorship contract with a manufacturer of an electronic gaming  
15                  device;
- 16                  (2) Is registered with the United States Department of Justice as a distributor of electronic  
17                  gaming devices; and
- 18                  (3) Has provided the Secretary of State Police with a copy of the person's current federal  
19                  registration.

- 21                  C. An instant bingo machine operated in compliance with COMAR 36.07.

22                  **.02 Unlawful Electronic Gaming Devices.**

23                  An electronic gaming device is unlawful if it is not authorized by Regulation .01 of this chapter.
