7 Authority: Criminal Law Article § 12-301, Annotated Code of Maryland

9 **.01 Registration.**

10 A. The Commission shall maintain a register of each location that offers skills-based amusement
11 devices that award noncash prizes with a wholesale value in excess of \$30.

12 B. A person who operates a skills-based amusement device shall annually register with the
13 Commission if the device awards noncash prizes with a wholesale value in excess of \$30 and is:

14 (1) A redemption device;

15 (2) A merchandiser device; or

16 (3) Another type of skills-based amusement device.

17 C. A person required to register shall provide in a manner specified by the Commission:

18 (1) The name of person operating the device;

19 (2) The address of the location where the device is operated;

20 (3) A total count of the devices in operation with an indication whether the device is:

21 (a) A redemption device;

22 (b) A merchandiser device;

23 (c) Another type of skills-based amusement device; and

24 (4) A written explanation as to how the device awards prizes that includes;

25 (a) A description of how the game operates;

26 (b) The maximum noncash merchandise or prize wholesale value offered; and

27 (c) Technical and operator manuals; and

28 (5) Any additional information required by the Commission.

29 D. Upon review of a request submitted under § C of this regulation, the Commission may:

- 1 (1) Require testing of a device under COMAR 36.08.03; and
 - 2 (2) Approve of the request and list the maximum wholesale prize value in the registration
 - 3 certificate issued under § E; or
 - 4 (3) Deny the request.
- 5 E. A decision of the Commission to deny a request under § D(3) of this regulation is final and
- 6 not appealable.
- 7 F. For each location registered under this chapter, the Commission shall:
- 8 (1) Assign a skills-based amusement device location registration number; and
 - 9 (2) Issue a registration certificate.
- 10 G. A person required to register under this chapter shall display to the public the Commission
- 11 issued registration certificate at the location where the devices are operated.
