Hollywood Casino at Perryville

Underage on casino floor: 1

On 6/6/14, as a result of identifying subjects involved in a fight in the parking lot, it was discovered that one subject was under 21 years of age and had been in the casino prior to the incident. The subject did gamble and consumed alcohol while in the casino.

Intoxicated patrons evicted: 0

Children unattended in vehicles: 0

Excluded persons in casino: 1

On 6/7/14, a male subject who is enrolled in VEP was located on the gaming floor. PPD responded and charged the subject with trespass.

Underage on casino floor: 0

Intoxicated patrons evicted: 3

On 6/23/14, an intoxicated male was found sleeping at a VLT. A cab was called for him and he was evicted from the property.

On 6/26/14, a female was identified as being too intoxicated to remain on the gaming floor and was evicted.

On 6/28/14, a male was identified as being too intoxicated to remain on the gaming floor and was evicted.

On 6/23/14, a subcontractor working at the casino reported the theft of a construction trailer. WCSO responded and is investigating.

Maryland Live Casino

Underage on casino floor: 2

On 6/7/14, a male subject and a minor child gained access to an employee elevator and exited onto the casino floor. They walked through the casino and upon exiting were challenged by a security guard. The minor did not gamble or consume alcohol while on the floor.

On 6/21/14, an underage female was identified at the Live Rewards desk. She had arrived with a group on a bus trip and entered through the east entrance without being challenged by security.

Intoxicated patrons evicted: 3

On 6/3/14, an intoxicated male patron, who had been previously banned, was again evicted from the casino. The subject was arrested by AACOPD for trespass.

On 6/7/14, a male subject was identified as being too intoxicated to remain on the gaming floor and was evicted. After several attempts to get back inside, he was arrested by AACOPD.

On 6/18/14, an intoxicated male subject was evicted.

Children unattended in vehicles: 1

On 6/30/14, security responded to a vehicle in the parking garage in reference to two (2) children left unattended. The children were 6 and 8 years of age. The parents were located in the casino and had been in there for several hours. AACOPD responded and is investigating.

Excluded persons in casino: 1

On 6/6/14, a male subject who is enrolled in VEP was located at the cashier's cage attempting to obtain a cash advance.

Physical altercations: 3

On 6/3/14, a female patron reported to security that she had been assaulted by another female patron over a dispute about a VLT.

On 6/15/14, two (2) patrons became involved in an altercation on an elevator. Security and AACOPD escorted them from the property.

On 6/15/14, two (2) patrons became involved in an altercation in the High Limits table games area. Both were evicted.

Theft/Robbery: 7

On 6/10/14, a patron reported to security that someone had stolen items from his vehicle parked in the garage.

On 6/10/14, a patron, who had left her VLT in the care of a slot team member, returned and found that someone had taken her voucher.

On 6/22/14, a patron reported that someone had stolen items from his vehicle in the parking garage. A suspect was located and arrested.

On 6/23/14, a patron fell asleep at a VLT and another subject cashed out his voucher.

On 6/24/14, a subject took a \$500.00 chip that had already been bet on a Pai Gow table and left the casino.

On 6/29/14, a patron reported to security that items had been stolen from his vehicle while it was parked in the garage. AACOPD is investigating.

On 6/29/14, a patron reported to security that items had been stolen from her vehicle while it was parked in the garage. AACOPD is investigating.

Employee theft: 3

On 6/2/14, two (2) employees were terminated for the theft of money from a patron's wallet.

On 6/5/13 a bartender was terminated for ongoing thefts.

On 6/25/14, a cash cage employee was arrested by AACOPD for the theft of approximately \$150,000.00 in cash.

Underage on casino floor: 0

Intoxicated patrons evicted: 1

On 6/6/14, a male patron was identified as being too intoxicated to remain on the gaming floor. A room was located for the subject to sleep it off.

On 6/21/14 a domestic assault occurred on the gaming floor. The subjects were separated and no law enforcement involvement was requested.

Theft/Robbery: 4

On 6/6/14, a patron reported to security that she had forgotten to remove \$1,357.00 from a redemption kiosk. A male subject was identified as taking the money. MSP is investigating.

On 6/23/14, a patron forgot to remove \$70.00 from a redemption kiosk and another subject took the money. The subject was identified and the money was returned.

On 6/26/14, a subject reported to security that someone had taken his voucher valued at \$75.37.

On 6/28/14, a subject reported to security that someone had taken his voucher valued at \$55.62.
