## **Hollywood Casino at Perryville**

Underage on casino floor: 0

## **Maryland Live Casino**

Underage on casino floor: 2

On 7/3/14, three (3) possible underage subjects climbed a fence at the east entrance, entered the casino and ran through the gaming floor. Security began a pursuit of the subjects as soon as they entered. Security was unable to catch them and all three subjects ran out of another entrance and were not detained or identified. None of the subjects gambled or consumed alcohol. The entire incident lasted less than two (2) minutes.

On 7/24/14, an underage male entered through the east entrance into the casino. He produced identification which was checked by two (2) security guards. The subject was identified as being underage when he approached the Live Rewards desk at which time he was found to be 20 years of age. He was identified and evicted from the casino.

Intoxicated patrons evicted: 2

On 7/4/14, a male subject was evicted for intoxication and became involved in a physical altercation with security and AACOPD.

On 7/24/14, a male subject was evicted for intoxication and became involved in a physical altercation with security and AACOPD.

Children unattended in vehicles: 0

Vulnerable adults unattended in vehicles: 1

On 7/21/14, security was notified by other patrons of an unattended vulnerable adult in a vehicle in the parking garage. Investigation revealed that a male subject had left his elderly mother in the vehicle for at least five (5) hours while he gambled in the casino. AACOPD were notified and the male subject was arrested. The elderly female was placed in the care of the AACO Mobile Crisis Unit.

On 7/26/14, a female subject who is enrolled in VEP was located on the gaming floor when she identified herself at the cash cage.

On 7/29/14, a male subject who is enrolled in VEP was located on the gaming floor when she identified herself at the cash cage.

Physical altercations: 3

On 7/4/14, two (2) male patrons were evicted for becoming involved in a physical altercation.

On 7/25/14, two (2) male patrons were evicted for becoming involved in a physical altercation.

On 7/26/14, two (2) male patrons were evicted for becoming involved in a physical altercation.

Theft/Robbery: 7

On 7/1/14, a male subject was arrested for stealing \$75.00 worth of chips from another patron.

On 7/3/14, a patron reported to security that someone had taken his voucher valued at \$200.00.

On 7/3/14, a patron reported to security that someone had taken \$50.00 in chips from his table position while using the restroom.
