10 **.06 Supplemental Wagers.**

11 A. When a player makes a Pass Bet and a total of 4, 5, 6, 8, 9, or 10 is thrown on the come out
12 roll, the player may make a supplemental wager in support of the Pass Bet which may be limited
13 by the facility operator to an amount that is equal to the amount of the original Pass Bet, and if
14 the Pass Bet wins after a supplemental wager is made:

15 (1) The original Pass Bet shall be paid at odds of 1 to 1.

16 (2) The supplemental wager shall be paid at odds of:

17 (a) 2 to 1 if the come out point was 4 or 10;

18 (b) 3 to 2 if the come out point was 5 or 9; or

19 (c) 6 to 5 if the come out point was 6 or 8.

20 B. When a player makes a Don't Pass Bet and a total of 4, 5, 6, 8, 9, or 10 is thrown on the come
21 out roll, the player may make a supplemental wager in support of the Don't Pass Bet which may
22 be limited by the facility operator to an amount calculated as to provide winnings not in excess
23 of the amount originally wagered on the Don't Pass Bet, and if the Don't Pass Bet wins after a
24 supplemental wager is made:

25 (1) The original Don't Pass Bet shall be paid at odds of 1 to 1.

26 (2) The supplemental wager shall be paid at odds of:

27 (a) 1 to 2 if the come out point was 4 or 10;

1 (b) 2 to 3 if the come out point was 5 or 9; or

2 (c) 5 to 6 if the come out point was 6 or 8.

3 C. When a player makes a Come Bet and a total of 4, 5, 6, 8, 9, or 10 is thrown on the roll
4 immediately following placement of the Come Bet, the player may make a supplemental wager
5 in support of the Come Bet which may be limited by the facility operator to an amount that is
6 equal to the amount of the original Come Bet, and if the Come Bet wins after a supplemental
7 wager is made:

8 (1) The original Come Bet shall be paid at odds of 1 to 1.

9 (2) The supplemental wager shall be paid at odds of:

10 (a) 2 to 1 if the come point was 4 or 10;

11 (b) 3 to 2 if the come point was 5 or 9; or

12 (c) 6 to 5 if the come point was 6 or 8.

13 D. When a player makes a Don't Come Bet and a total of 4, 5, 6, 8, 9, or 10 is thrown on the roll
14 immediately following placement of the Don't Come Bet, the player may make a supplemental
15 wager in support of the Don't Come Bet which may be limited by the facility operator to an
16 amount calculated as to provide winnings not in excess of the amount originally wagered on the
17 Don't Come Bet, and if the Don't Come Bet wins after the supplemental wager is made:

18 (1) The original Don't Come Bet shall be paid at odds of 1 to 1.

19 (2) The supplemental wager shall be paid at odds of:

20 (a) 1 to 2 if the come point was a 4 or 10;

21 (b) 2 to 3 if the come point was 5 or 9; or

22 (c) 5 to 6 if the come point was 6 or 8.

1 E. Except as permitted under §F of this regulation, a facility operator may allow a supplemental
2 wager in support of a Pass or Come Bet in an amount up to ~~ten~~ **one hundred** times the amount of
3 the original Pass or Come Bet.

4 (1) A facility operator may allow a supplemental wager in support of a Don't Pass or
5 Don't Come Bet in an amount calculated as to provide a winning player with winnings
6 not in excess of up to ~~ten~~ **one hundred** times the amount originally wagered on the Don't
7 Pass or Don't Come Bet.

8 (2) The original Pass, Don't Pass, Come or Don't Come Bet and any supplemental wager
9 allowed in accordance with this subsection shall be paid at the same odds as the original
10 and supplemental wagers are paid under §§A—D of this regulation.

11 F. A facility operator may accept a supplemental wager that exceeds an amount that is otherwise
12 authorized by this section or posted as the maximum wager permitted if the excess amount of the
13 supplemental wager is necessary to facilitate the payouts permitted by this regulation.
