7 **.28 Progressive Video Lottery Terminals.**

8 A. through E. (text unchanged)

9 F. A progressive controller shall be:

10 (1) Located in a restricted area;

11 (2) Secured:

12 (a) In a dual key controlled compartment with:

13 (i) One key controlled by **the operations department** ~~manufacturer or~~
14 ~~the facility manager~~; and

15 (ii) One key controlled by the **security department** ~~Commission~~; or

16 (b) By alternative means approved by the Commission; and

17 (3) Capable of:

18 (a) Displaying an available progressive jackpot amount on a video lottery
19 terminal's:

20 (i) Progressive meter; or

21 (ii) Common progressive meter;

22 (b) Transmitting to a video lottery terminal for metering purposes the amount of a
23 progressive jackpot;

24 (c) If linked to a common progressive meter in accordance with §H of this
25 regulation, displaying the Commission asset number of the video lottery terminal
26 on which a progressive jackpot is won;

27 (d) If a progressive controller is servicing multiple video lottery terminals,
28 automatically resetting all video lottery terminals connected to it to a pre-
29 established reset amount; and

30 (e) If the progressive offers multiple jackpot levels, maintaining and displaying
31 for each progressive level the:

32 (i) Number of progressive jackpots won;

33 (ii) Cumulative amount paid;

34 (iii) Maximum progressive payout;

35 (iv) Minimum amount or reset amount; and

36 (v) Rate of progression.
