



# **Maryland State Lottery And Gaming Control Agency Casino Compliance Unit Monthly Report February 2014**

## **Hollywood Casino at Perryville**

Underage on casino floor: 0

Intoxicated patrons evicted: 4

On 2/16/14, a male patron was identified as being too intoxicated to remain on the gaming floor and was evicted.

On 2/16/14, a female patron was identified as being too intoxicated to remain on the gaming floor and was evicted.

On 2/23/14, a female patron was identified as being too intoxicated to remain on the gaming floor.

On 2/27/14, a female patron was identified as being intoxicated and causing a disturbance in the Celebrity Grille. She was evicted from the casino.

On 2/10/14, a male patron was evicted for intoxication. He attempted to re-enter the casino and was subsequently arrested by AACOPD.

On 2/17/14, a male subject who was intoxicated and disorderly was arrested by AACOPD.

On 2/20/14, a male subject who is enrolled in the VEP was located on the gaming floor at the cashier's cage.

Physical altercations: 3

On 2/15/14, security responded to a report of an altercation at the Live Rewards counter. One of the subjects was evicted from the property.

On 2/22/14, security responded to a report of a fight in the Noodles Restaurant. AACOPD responded and the subjects were evicted from the property.

On 2/23/14, security responded to the poker room in reference to a fight. They were both evicted from the property.

Theft/Robbery: 11

On 2/1/14 a male patron reported to security that while playing blackjack at Pit 1, he placed his cell phone on the chair next to him and when he went to retrieve it the phone was missing.

On 2/1/14, a female patron reported to security that after using the restroom, she returned to the VLT she had been playing and noticed that her wallet was missing.

On 2/1/14, security responded to a call for a male subject chasing another male subject and a female subject out of the casino. The male subject accused the two of taking his wallet. The male and female suspects were arrested by AACOPD for theft.

On 2/3/14, a male patron left his chips on a table he was playing at while he went to the restroom. Another male subject took the chips and exited the casino.

On 2/7/14, a housekeeping employee reported to security that a male subject had stolen the money from the tip jar in the restroom.

On 2/8/14, a male patron was identified as having stolen \$100.00 in chips from another male patron seated next to him.

On 2/16/14, a male patron reported to security that he had lost his wallet. AACOPD responded and conducted a theft investigation.

On 2/18/14, a male patron reported to security that someone had stolen the voucher from the VLT he was playing.

On 2/18/14, a male subject hit a jackpot for \$974.25 in the high limit slot area and proceeded to the cash cage. He forgot to take the voucher with him and when he returned to retrieve it the voucher was missing.

On 2/19/14, a male subject was identified as having taken several winning bets that weren't his on the Spin Wheel game. He was directed to make restitution and was then evicted from the casino.

On 2/24/14, a male subject stole \$60.00 worth of chips from another male subject while they were playing Texas Hold Um. The suspect was detained and returned the chips he had taken. The suspect was evicted from the property.

#### Employee theft: 1

On 2/8/14, management terminated a table games dealer for theft of \$420.00 from the table he was working at. AACOPD responded and the subject was arrested for theft. The money was located on his person at the time of arrest. The suspect further advised that he had stolen money on several prior occasions.

#### Drugs: 1
