Hollywood Casino at Perryville

Underage on casino floor: 0

Intoxicated patrons evicted: 1

On 5/2/15, a male subject was identified as being too intoxicated to remain on the gaming floor and was evicted. He left in a taxi. 14283

Children unattended: 0

Excluded persons in casino: 0

Physical altercations: 1

On 5/9/15, two (2) male subjects became involved in a physical altercation. PPD and EMTs responded. One (1) subject was treated on site for an injury and both parties left the property. 14452

Employee theft: 1

On 5/2/15, an employee allegedly picked up a chip from the floor and did not turn it in as per casino regulations. 14290

Casino at Ocean Downs

Underage on casino floor: 1

On 5/24/15, an underage male subject was denied entry at the front entrance of the casino. He and his father then went to the rear entrance near the smoking patio and entered the casino. The underage subject did gamble on a slot machine before being confronted by security. He was identified, charged by MSP with trespass and evicted. 14758

Intoxicated patrons evicted: 7

On 5/1/15, two male subjects were identified as being too intoxicated to remain on the gaming floor and were evicted. 14259

On 5/8/15, a male subject was identified as being too intoxicated to remain on the gaming floor and was evicted. 14450

On 5/9/15, a male subject was identified as being too intoxicated to remain on the gaming floor and was evicted. 14453

On 5/20/15, a male subject was identified as being too intoxicated to remain on the gaming floor and was evicted. 14681

On 5/30/15, a male subject was identified as too intoxicated to re-enter the casino after exiting previously. In addition to being intoxicated, he had been harassing patrons at the Dine and Dash.

On 5/30/15, a female subject was identified as being too intoxicated to remain on the gaming floor and was evicted. 14865

Excluded persons in casino: 1

On 5/29/15, a female subject who won a jackpot was identified as being enrolled in VEP. The subject was charged by WCSO for trespass. 14850.

Physical altercations: 0

Theft/Robbery: 3

On 5/11/15, a patron dropped a voucher valued at \$40.18. An unidentified female suspect picked it up, played it in a slot machine and then left the casino. 14500

On 5/14/15, a patron reported that she could not locate five (5) \$20.00 bills. A review by surveillance revealed that she dropped the money and a male subject picked it up, played it in a slot machine and then departed. The suspect has been identified. 14580

On 5/19/15, a patron dropped a \$100.00 bill which was then picked up by a female suspect. The suspect was located in a vehicle in the parking lot. When confronted by security she denied taking the money. MSP responded and the suspect was arrested. 14682

On 5/23/15, a patron reported that someone had stolen her voucher valued at \$115.00. A male suspect was identified and returned the money. 14747

Employee theft: 1

On 5/19/15, a casino employee was identified as having stolen tip money from another employee. 14661

Maryland Live Casino

Underage on casino floor: 1

On 5/9/15 a male subject and his sixteen (16) year old son entered the casino through the BOH employee entrance. Once inside they walked through BOH and ascended the stairs leading up to the gaming floor. Both subjects were on the gaming floor when confronted by security. The subjects were not challenged during several contacts with casino employees. 14467

Intoxicated patrons evicted: 2

On 5/11/15, a male subject was identified as being too intoxicated to remain on the gaming floor and was evicted. 14500

On 5/25/15, an intoxicated female subject who is a contract employee with Town Park/Valet at the casino was arrested by AACOPD for disorderly conduct. 14766

Children unattended: 0

Excluded persons in casino: 3

On 5/9/15, a male subject enrolled in VEP was identified at the main cage after playing several slot machines. He was charged by AACOPD with trespass and was evicted. 14469

On 5/24/15, a male subject enrolled in VEP was found to be gambling at various tables. When approached he handed security his identification then hastily departed the casino without his identification card. 14774

On 5/25/15, a male subject enrolled in VEP was located gambling at Pit 4. He was arrested by AACOPD for trespass. 14777

Physical altercations: 6

On 5/4/15, a male subject was arrested by AACOPD for assaulting a casino security guard. 14330

On 5/5/15, two females (2) became involved in a physical altercation and were evicted. 14331

On 5/10/15, a male subject and a female subject became involved in a physical altercation. 14477

On 5/13/15, two (2) male subjects were involved in a physical altercation. AACOPD responded and referred one of the subjects to the commissioner to press charges. 14591

On 5/13/15, two (2) male subjects were involved in a physical altercation. Both were evicted. 14574

On 5/25/15, a male subject was evicted for physically assaulting another male patron. 14781

Theft/Robbery: 7

On 5/7/15, a male subject entered into Pit 3 and stole twenty three (23) \$1,000.00 chips then fled by jumping off of the poker room smoking area then departing in a vehicle. AACOPD is investigating. 14419

On 5/10/15, a male subject stole \$88.00 from a party starter's tray. The subject was confronted by security and AACOPD and made restitution before being evicted. 14478.

On 5/13/15, a patron reported that someone had stolen a \$500.00 chip he had dropped. A suspect was identified as having taken the chip. The money was not recovered. The suspect was evicted. 14577

On 5/18/15, a patron reported that someone had stolen \$335.00 worth of chips from him. A suspect was identified and arrested. The money was returned to the owner. 14662

On 5/27/15, an unknown male subject took a staged cold box from a VLT and departed the casino with the box. 14797

On 5/27/15, a male subject was identified as having stolen a sweatshirt from another patron. The garment was returned and he was evicted. 14810

Underage on casino floor: 0

Intoxicated patrons evicted: 5

On 5/1/15, two (2) male patrons were evicted after becoming disorderly when told they needed to slow down on their alcohol consumption. 14260

On 5/2/15, a male subject was identified as being too intoxicated to remain on the gaming floor and was evicted. 14285

On 5/2/15, a male subject was identified as being too intoxicated to remain on the gaming floor and was evicted. Due to his level of intoxication a room at the hotel was made available to him. 14704

On 5/29/15, an intoxicated male subject was located BOH. A review of video showed that he had entered through the employee entrance. Security located him and he was evicted. 14863

On 5/31/15, a male subject was identified as being too intoxicated to remain on the gaming floor and was evicted. 14869

Physical altercations: 0

Theft/Robbery: 6

On 5/7/15, a patron reported that someone had stolen two vouchers valued at \$11.45. A suspect was identified and when confronted by security he paid the money back. 14424

On 5/9/15, when a patron fell asleep at a slot machine, another subject cashed out his voucher valued at \$432.32. The unknown suspect then left the casino. 14457

On 5/16/15, a patron reported that someone had stolen her voucher valued at \$20.00. A suspect was identified and the money was returned. 14623

On 5/24/15, a male subject reported that someone had stolen his voucher valued at \$43.00. A suspect was identified and restitution was made to the victim. 14778

On 5/28/15, a patron reported that someone had taken her voucher valued at \$91.85. A suspect was identified and restitution was made to the victim. 14834

On 5/31/15, a subject reported that someone had taken \$101.00 that she had left in the redemption kiosk. A suspect was identified and the money was returned to the victim. 14873

Horseshoe Casino

Underage on casino floor: 2

On 5/17/15, an underage female attempted enter the casino but was refused. She advised the security supervisor that she needed to use the bathroom and the supervisor allowed a security guard to escort her to the rest room near the cage. She was then escorted back to the security podium and exited the casino. 14629

On 5/24/15, a female subject carrying a small child entered the casino and walked past the security podium. She only made it a short distance past the podium before being stopped and turned around by security. 14761

Intoxicated patrons evicted: 4

On 5/13/15, a male subject was identified as being too intoxicated to remain on the gaming floor. The subject became disorderly and BPD became involved. The subject was evicted. 14575

On 5/16/15, a male subject was identified as being too intoxicated to remain on the gaming floor and was evicted. 14627

On 5/26/15, a male subject was approached by security and BPD in reference to his disorderly behavior. The subject appeared to be intoxicated and continued to be disorderly with BPD. He was arrested and evicted. 14783

On 5/31/15, an intoxicated male subject was located BOH. A review by surveillance showed that he entered BOH through access doors near the Harbor Room that had been propped open. The subject was evicted. 14876

Children unattended: 0

Excluded persons in casino: 3

On 5/6/15, a female subject who is enrolled in VEP was located in the poker room. She was charged with trespass by BPD and evicted. 14374

On 5/12/15, a male subject who is enrolled in VEP was located on the gaming floor at Pit 5. He was charged with trespass by BPD and evicted. 14554

On 5/21/15, a male subject who is enrolled in VEP was located at the second floor cash cage. Two (2) \$5.00 chips were forfeited by the subject. He was charged with trespass by BPD and evicted. 14715

Physical altercations: 4

On 5/15/15, two (2) male subjects became involved in a physical altercation. Both were evicted. 14598

On 5/18/15, two (2) male subjects became involved in a physical altercation. The aggressor was arrested by BPD. 14656

On 5/21/15, a male subject and a female subject became involved in a physical altercation. The female subject decided not to pursue charges and the male subject was evicted. 14748

On 5/29/15, a male subject and a female subject became involved in a physical altercation. The female subject decided not to pursue charges and the male subject was evicted. 14838

Theft/Robbery: 5

On 5/4/15 a female subject was identified as having stolen over \$500.00 worth of chips from another subject. The chips were returned to the victim and the suspect was evicted. 14306

On 5/5/15, a male subject was arrested by BPD for possession of, and passing counterfeit currency. 14369

On 5/9/15, a female subject was identified as having stolen \$100.00 in chips from another patron. The chips were recovered and the subject was evicted. 14462

On 5/16/15, a patron reported that someone had stolen his cell phone. A female suspect was identified and when confronted by security she returned the phone and was then evicted. 14615

On 5/21/15, a male subject was identified as having stolen \$204.00 worth of chips from another player. When confronted by security, he made restitution to the victim and was then evicted. 14738

Drugs: 3

On 5/10/15, a patron dropped a bag containing a white substance in the poker room. The subject was evicted. 14479

On 5/17/15, a subject gave a beverage server a tip of \$1.00 along with two (2) bags containing a white powder type substance. The subject then left the casino. BPD responded and the substance was disposed of. 14628

On 5/18/15, a patron reported that someone had stolen \$677.00 that he had dropped near the cage. A male suspect was identified and arrested by BPD. A portion of the money was recovered. 14660

On 5/20/15, a male subject was identified as having stolen three (3) \$1,000.00 chips from a table. The unknown suspect then proceeded to the cage, cashed out the chips and left the casino. 14851

Employee theft: 1

On 5/23/15, a male subject employed at the casino as a dealer was investigated on suspicion of conspiring with other subjects to give them an advantage while gambling at

card games. The subject was arrested by BPD for theft. A loss of \$3,947.50 has been identified by the casino. 14851

Miscellaneous: 1

On 5/12/15, a male subject climbed over the wall of the smoker's area after being turned away at the entrance due to his identification being expired. He was evicted from the property. 14507
