Hollywood Casino at Perryville

Underage on casino floor: 0

On 8/3/14, a female patron who was identified as being too intoxicated to remain on the gaming floor was evicted from the casino.

Underage on casino floor: 1

On 8/10/14, an underage male and an underage female were located on the casino floor. A review by surveillance revealed that they had entered the front door and their identification had not been checked. Both subjects had gambled on several VLTs. They were in the casino for approximately fifty (50) minutes before they were discovered and subsequently evicted.

Underage on casino floor: 2

On 8/6/14, a toddler ran under the ropes at the north entrance and entered onto the gaming floor. The child's mother ran after him, grabbed him by the arm, and left the casino with him.

On 8/10/14, an underage male subject was located on the gaming floor. It was determined through a review by surveillance that the subject presented identification at the entrance. The identification was checked visually by a security guard however it was not scanned through the verifier. The subject was in the area of VLTs and table games however he did not gamble at any time. He was evicted from the casino.

Intoxicated patrons evicted: 3

On 8/7/14, a female subject was identified as being too intoxicated to remain on the gaming floor. While being evicted, she became combative and was arrested by AACOPD.

On 8/28/14, a male subject was evicted for being intoxicated and disorderly at a black jack table.

On 8/31/14, a male subject was evicted for bringing two (2) bottles of liquor in with him and for being intoxicated.

On 8/23/14, a male subject who is enrolled in VEP was located on the gaming floor when he attempted to obtain a cash advance from the cash cage.

Physical altercations: 1

On 8/31/14, a male subject was evicted for physically assaulting a roulette dealer.

Theft/Robbery: 6

On 8/5/14, a patron reported to security that someone had stolen \$100.00 worth of chips from a cup holder at a table he was playing at.

On 8/7/14, a patron reported to security that someone had stolen \$50.00 worth of chips from his seat at a table.

On 8/15/14, a female patron reported to security that someone had entered her vehicle and stolen \$20.00 from her purse.

On 8/24/14, a male subject was arrested by AACOPD for the theft of \$80.00 in chips from another patron.

On 8/24/14, a male subject was arrested by AACOPD for the theft of another patron's wallet.

On 8/24/14, a patron reported to security that someone had stolen two (2) handguns from his vehicle while it was parked in the garage. AACOPD responded to investigate the incident.

On 8/26/14, a patron reported to security that someone had stolen his cell phone while he was in Luk Fu.

Underage on casino floor: 2

On 8/7/14, an underage male subject was located on the casino floor. The subject entered the casino while the security guard was apparently distracted by another family member of the underage. A review by surveillance revealed that the subject did gamble on a VLT however he was not observed consuming any alcohol. The subject was identified and evicted from the casino.

On 8/10/14, as a result of a separate investigation into the passing of counterfeit bills by three (3) male subjects, it was discovered that one of the subjects was eighteen (18) years of age. Investigation revealed that the subject had entered the casino using someone else's identification, and while in the casino he did gamble on several VLTs. The underage subject did not consume any alcoholic beverages.

On 8/24/14, a male subject was identified as being too intoxicated to remain on the gaming floor and was evicted.
