ISSUE SUMMARY

Staff recommended the revocation of Stephen Oguledo's video lottery employee license in March 2016. Mr. Oguledo requested a hearing on this recommendation. The Director delegated the hearing to the Office of Administrative Hearings ("OAH"). The OAH held an evidentiary hearing on January 9, 2017, where Mr. Oguledo was required to show, by clear and convincing evidence, that he was qualified to hold a video lottery employee license.

The OAH issued a final decision on February 28, 2017 that affirmed the recommendation to revoke Mr. Oguledo's video lottery employee license. Mr. Fontaine's report for the March 2017 Commission meeting included a copy of the OAH decision, which is also attached to this memorandum. Mr. Oguledo did not file a petition for judicial review of OAH decision.

After a hearing, the Commission is required to make a determination on the license revocation. Md. Code Ann., State Gov't § 9-1A-04(a)(3). Because the Agency delegated to OAH the authority to conduct an evidentiary hearing and issue a final decision, the Commission is tasked with carrying out that decision by revoking Mr. Oguledo's video lottery employee license. Procedurally, the Commission needed to wait until the end of the appeals period after the OAH hearing before taking this final action.

Revocation of Mr. Oguledo's video lottery employee license.
