We are conducting a hearing on the manufacturers license application submitted by Cummins Illinois, Inc. The Maryland Lottery and Gaming Control Agency is required by “The Gaming Law” to conduct an investigation to determine if Cummins Illinois, Inc. is qualified to be awarded a manufacturers license.

You (the commissioners) have been provided with the complete investigative report on Cummins Illinois, Inc. You have also received a copy of the public report that was in your packets and made available to everyone on the agency website. I will summarize the reports that have been given to you.

Background

Cummins Illinois, Inc. (the “Company”) was incorporated in Illinois in May 1999, and has its corporate offices located in Mount Prospect, Illinois. Cummins Illinois, Inc. engages in the sale and service of coin and currency processing equipment and supplies manufactured exclusively by the Cummins-Allison Corporation.

Cummins Illinois is currently licensed by several Native American tribal agencies and commissions in Louisiana, and by the Louisiana State Police Indian Gaming Unit.

Ownership of Applicant

Paul A. Jones and William J. Jones are sole co-owners of Cummins Illinois, Inc. Both Paul Jones and William Jones hold executive positions and serve on the Board of Directors of the Cummins-Allison Corporation, and both are currently licensed by the Commission as Principal Employees.

Our financial and background investigations of Cummins Illinois, Inc. found the following:

- 1) Cummins Illinois, Inc. was found to have financial stability, integrity and responsibility
- 2) There are no material issues involving the known financial backers
- 3) Cummins Illinois, Inc. possesses the requisite good character, honesty and integrity
- 4) Cummins Illinois, Inc. has sufficient business ability and experience
- 5) There are no potential disqualifying factors

CONCLUSIONS and OPINION

MLGCA's investigation has confirmed that the Applicant has sufficient financial resources and found no derogatory information regarding the Applicants'

qualifications. Based on the criteria in SG §§ 9-1A-07(c)(7) and 9-1A-08(d), we conclude that the Applicant has established by clear and convincing evidence its qualifications for a manufacturer license.
