- 2) Next audit committee meeting scheduled for December 13, 2018.
- 3) IRS MOU a draft of requested changes was submitted to the IRS on August 10, 2018 for review and comments and we await their response.
- 4) Hollywood Casino is scheduled to close their facility on the evening of October 23, 2018 to facilitate the repair of their UPS system and will re-open the afternoon of October 24.
- 5) Live! Casino Casino floor project scheduled between October 22 to December 14 will result in the reduction of 135 slots and 3 table games.

- ITLM Update As of 10/15/18, 352 ITLMs in 84 unique Veterans' Posts are currently operational. The ITLM Program as a whole has contributed over \$14.4 million in profits to the participating Posts since September 2014.
- Phase II (Prizes over \$600) rolled out at 5 pilot sites September 13<sup>th</sup>-14<sup>th</sup>. Each pilot site will be receiving an additional Phase II machine the week of October 29<sup>th</sup> for continued testing.
- 3) Staff attended a 2-day GLI University training conducted here at MLGCA HQ. Topics covered included components of a game, slot math, GLI tools, progressive systems, on-line accounting systems, and advanced math.
- Central System, Failover to Back-up Data Center (BDC) on Sept. 18<sup>th</sup> the Primary Data Center lost power as a result of a lightning strike. The System failed over to the BDC flawlessly. The System operated out of the BDC until October 1<sup>st</sup>.

### D <u>Responsible Gambling</u>

- 1) Voluntary Exclusion Program
  - a) 26 new participants joined the casino VEP program in September; the current number of active participants is 1,918.
  - b) There were 5 removals from the VEP in September and 246 in total.
  - c) To date, 573 violations have occurred since the casino VEP program began. All have been cited for criminal trespass and court resolution is pending.
  - d) There were 3 additional enrollments on the lottery VEP list and 2 removals; the total number of participants is 324.
  - e) There were no additional enrollments to the bingo hall VEP program for this reporting period; the total number of participants is 9.
- 2) The launch of the new electronic VEP notification process is currently in progress.
- 3) A meeting was held in September between the Lottery, the Maryland Department of Health and the Center of Excellence to further collaborate on responsible gambling initiatives.
- 4) The next MARG meeting is scheduled for October 30, 2018 at MGMNH.
