Executive Summary

A. Introduction

As a prerequisite to being eligible for the award of an Instant Bingo Facility License (“facility license”), an applicant for a facility license must submit a facility license application to the Maryland Lottery and Gaming Control Commission (“the Commission”). The applicant must prove to the Commission, by clear and convincing evidence, that it meets the qualification criteria set forth in COMAR Title 36.07.02.11 and otherwise comply with relevant licensing regulations. An applicant must provide all information to the Commission that is necessary for a qualification determination as to the applicant, its principals, and its principal entities.

During the preceding several months, the Maryland Lottery and Gaming Control Agency (“MLGCA,” “we” or “our”) reviewed each facility’s hours of operation, facility design standards, compliance with the testing of instant bingo machines, gaming floor plan, internal controls, surveillance plan, security plan, responsible gaming plan and minimum bankroll requirements. Based on this information and the cooperation with the Agency by each facility, the Agency sought and received the Commission’s approval of instant bingo operations at the instant bingo facilities listed below. The outstanding issue with each of these instant bingo operations was the licensure of all employees and entities that are required to be licensed. The facility licenses were to be issued to these facilities upon the Agency’s completion of those background investigations, provided the investigations revealed no derogatory information. The Agency has conducted a suitability background license investigation of the below listed facilities (“the Applicants”) and their respective principal employees in connection with their

B. Findings

The MLGCA conducted complete and thorough background investigations as authorized by reviewing corporate records and documents of the business operations, practices and transactions of the applicants and individual principals, focusing on required qualification criteria involving integrity and financial stability. MLGCA adhered to well-defined and approved investigative protocols in assembling the factual information incorporated in this report.

C. Conclusions and Opinion

MLGCA's investigation has confirmed that the Applicants have satisfied the requirements set forth in COMAR Title 36.07.02.11 with no derogatory information regarding the Applicants' qualifications. Therefore, we conclude that each Applicant, and their respective individual principals, have established by clear and convincing evidence their qualifications for an Instant Bingo Facility Operation License.
