12 13	C. The entry of an individual on the mandatory exclusion list may shall include at least the following identifying sufficient information to identify the excluded individual.
14	D. The information used to identify an excluded individual may include:
15	(1) Individual's <u>The individual's</u> :
16	(a) Name and any nickname or alias;
17	(b) Residential address;
18	(c) Telephone numbers;

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1	(d) Gender;
2	(e) Physical description, including any birthmarks, scars, or tattoos;
3	(f) Race or ethnic origin;
4	(g) For non-United States citizens, country of origin; and
5	(h) Photograph;
6	(2) Date of placement on the mandatory exclusion list;
7 8	(3) Brief statement of the basis for placing the individual on the mandatory exclusion list; and
9	(4) Any other information the Commission requires.
10 11 12	D. <u>E.</u> The mandatory exclusion list and related records shall be considered a <u>are</u> public records <u>records</u> under <u>State Government</u> <u>General Provisions</u> Article, §10-611 <u>4-101</u> , Annotated Code of Maryland.
13	.04 Inclusion on Mandatory Exclusion List.
14 15	A. Upon receipt of information that reasonably indicates an individual meets any criteria under Regulation .03B of this chapter, the Director shall:
16	(1) Evaluate the information;
17 18	(2) Ensure that the information required under Regulation .03CD of this chapter is complete sufficiently identifies the individual; and
19	(3) Decide whether to place the individual on the mandatory exclusion list.

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1 2	B. If the Director places <u>decides to place</u> an individual on the mandatory exclusion list, staff shall deliver to the individual by regular U.S. mail a written notice explaining:
3 4	(1) That the individual has been placed on a mandatory exclusion list that will be distributed to all facility operators in the State and be publicly available;
5	(2) The factual basis for placing the individual on the mandatory exclusion list;
6 7	(3) (2) The availability of an appeal hearing before the Commission a reconsideration meeting with the Director or the Director's designee;
8 9	(4) (3) The requirements for filing an appeal submitting a request for a reconsideration meeting;
10 11 12	(5) (4) That if no appeal is filed a timely reconsideration request is not submitted , the individual's name shall remain <u>be placed</u> on the <u>a mandatory</u> exclusion list <u>that will be</u> <u>distributed to all facility operators in the State and be publicly available</u>; and
13	(6) (5) That the excluded individual is shall be:
14 15	(a) Prohibited from entering any video lottery facility, and playing any video lottery terminal or table game, in the State;
16 17	(b) Subject to criminal charges for trespassing or any other appropriate criminal charge, and
18	(b) (c) Required to:
19 20 21	(i) Redeem or liquidate an unredeemed item with monetary value that the individual has received since being placed on the mandatory exclusion list, and

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1 2 3		(ii)Surrender to the Problem Gambling Fund established under State Government Article, §9-1A-33 any unredeemed items and prizes won at a video lottery facility after placement on the mandatory exclusion list.
4	<u>C.</u>	Reconsideration Meeting
5 6 7		(1) An individual may submit to the Director a written request for a reconsideration meeting within 15 days of the date of the individual's receipt of the notice described in §B of this regulation.
8 9		(2) If an individual fails to timely submit a request under §C(1) of this regulation, the individual shall be placed on the exclusion list.
10 11		(3) A reconsideration meeting may be held by the Director or the Director's designee;
12		(4) During a reconsideration meeting, an individual may:
13		(a) Be represented by counsel; and
14 15		(b) Present evidence as to why the individual does not meet the criteria under Regulation .03B of this chapter;
16 17		(5) The Director or the Director's designee shall deliver to the individual by regular U.S. mail a written notice of the decision following the reconsideration meeting.
18 19		(6) An individual dissatisfied with the result of a reconsideration meeting may submit a written request to the Commission for an appeal.
20		(7) The request for an appeal shall:
21 22		(a) Be submitted within 15 days of the date of the individual's receipt of the written notice of the decision following the reconsideration meeting; and

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1 2	(b) Describe the individual's legal and factual bases for disagreeing with placement on the mandatory exclusion list.
3 4	(8) If an individual fails to timely submit a written request for an appeal hearing under § C(7) of this regulation, the individual shall be placed on the exclusion list.
5 6	(9) Upon receipt of a timely written request for an appeal hearing, the Director shall provide the individual with a hearing notice for a hearing.
7	C. <u>D.</u> Appeal.
8 9 10	(1) An excluded individual may appeal placement on the mandatory exclusion list only by filing a written appeal to the Commission within 10 calendar days after receipt of the notice.
11 12 13 14	(2) If <u>after an appeal hearing</u> the Commission decides that the excluded individual does not meet any criteria under Regulation .03B of this chapter, the individual's name shall <u>not</u> be removed from <u>placed on</u> the mandatory exclusion list and the exclusion immediately terminated.
15 16	(3) (2) If <u>after an appeal hearing</u> the Commission decides that the excluded individual meets any criteria under Regulation .03B of this chapter:
17	(a) The individual's name shall remain <u>be placed</u> on the mandatory exclusion list;
18 19	(b) The Commission shall notify all facility operators in the State of the individual's addition to the mandatory exclusion list;
20	(c) The individual may seek judicial review of the Commission's decision; and
21 22	(d) The individual may request to be removed from the mandatory exclusion list only as provided in Regulation .05 of this chapter.

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1 .05 Removal from Mandatory Exclusion List.

A. After an excluded individual has been on the mandatory exclusion list for at least 5 years, the
individual may request removal from the mandatory exclusion list.

- B. An excluded individual's request under §A of this regulation shall be submitted to the
 Director in writing and shall include a detailed statement about why there is:
- 6 (1) Good cause for removal of the individual's name from the list; and
- 7 (2) A material change in the individual's circumstances since the individual's name was8 placed on the list.

9 C. <u>The Director or the Director's designee shall investigate the request and make a</u> 10 recommendation to the Commission whether to grant or deny the request.

11 The Commission shall hold a hearing on the excluded individual's request for removal from the

- 12 mandatory exclusion list.
- 13 D. If the Commission: Director or the Director's designee recommends removing the
- 14 individual from the list, the Commission may approve the recommendation without a
- 15 hearing, and Agency staff

16 (1) Grants the request, it shall:

- 17 (a) (1) Remove the individual from the mandatory exclusion list;
- (b) (2) Deliver to the individual by regular U.S. mail a notice of removal from the
 mandatory exclusion list; and
- 20(c) (3) Notify the State's facility operators of the individual's removal from the
mandatory exclusion list; or.

2 3	E. If the Director or the Director's designee recommends continued placement on the list, the excluded individual may submit a written appeal to Commission.
4	<u>F. Appeal.</u>
5	(1) The request for an appeal shall:
6 7 8	(a) Be submitted within 15 days of the date of the individual's receipt of the written notice of the recommendation of the Director or the Director's designee; and
9 10	(b) Describe the individual's legal and factual bases for disagreeing with recommendation.
11 12	(2) If an individual fails to timely submit a written request for an appeal hearing under § $F(1)(a)$ of this regulation, the individual shall remain on the exclusion list.
13 14	(3) Upon receipt of a timely written request for an appeal hearing, the Director shall provide the individual with a hearing notice for a hearing.
15 16	<u>G.</u> If after a hearing the Commission Denies denies the request, it shall deliver to the individual by regular U.S. mail a notice that the:
17	(a) (1) Request was denied; and
18	(b) (2) Individual shall remain on the mandatory exclusion list.
19	.06 Judicial Review.

3	.08 Facility Exclusion Plan.
4	A. (text unchanged)
5	B. The plan required under §A of this regulation shall include at least the following elements:
6	(1) Goals;
7	(2) Procedures and deadlines for implementation;
8	(3) Identification of facility personnel responsible for implementation;
9	(4) Responsibilities of facility personnel identified as responsible for implementation;
10	(5) Training for facility personnel on the requirements of this chapter;
11	(6) Regular monitoring of the mandatory exclusion list;
12	(7) Regular monitoring of other states' mandatory exclusion lists;
13 14	(8) Prompt reports to the Commission about the presence on facility premises of an individual who:
15	(a) Is included on the mandatory exclusion list; and
16	(b) Is required to be prevented from playing video lottery terminals or table games;
17 18	(9) (8) Prompt reports to the Commission about an individual who is permanently excluded from the facility;

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- (10) (9) The facility's response to the discovery of an individual who is on the
 mandatory exclusion list on facility property, which may include pursuing criminal
 charges against the individual; and
- 4 (11) (10) Any other element required by the Commission.
