11 12 13	<u>A.</u> A facility license holder may repair and replace its <u>instant</u> bingo machines provided that <u>documentation has been provided to the Commission, that evidences, to the satisfaction of the Commission that</u> :
14 15	<b>A.(1)</b> The machines operate in the same manner as <b>those</b> <u>any</u> that were in operation by that licensee on February 28, 2008; and
16 17	<b>B</b> <sub>-(2)</sub> The licensee does not operate more than the number of instant bingo machines the licensee had in operation on February 28, 2008.
18	<b>B. Documentation submitted under §A of this regulation may consist of:</b>
19	(1) Manufacturer invoices;
20	(2) Independent testing laboratory reports;
21	(3) Records from county licensing authorities; or
22	(4) Other records deemed acceptable by the Commission.
23 24	<u>C. A determination by the Commission on the sufficiency of documentation provided under</u> §B of this regulation is final and not appealable.
25 26	D. Instant bingo machines that are repaired or serve as a replacement shall comply with the technical standards as provided under COMAR 36.07.06.
